basic academic education. They learn from actual experience to work, play and pray together. Graduates of this specialized training find it much easier to take their places in society than otherwise would have been the case. The school has been described as a potent preventive against juvenile delinquency. There are four principal sources of income for the school—tuition, the Advisory Council, the Holy Childhood Guild and friends. Tuition provides only one-third of the operating costs, which approximate \$30,000 annually. Some families are able to pay full tuition, others only part, many none at all. No child is refused enrollment because of lack of tuition. There is a long waiting list of applicants. MANY CHILDREN leaving the school are placed in jobs through the school's placement services. Personal contact is maintained with graduates. The school originated in 1946 with the establishment of "craft classes" at Immaculate Conception parochial school. In 1951 it was transferred to the Andrews Street location. Since its beginning it has graduated nearly 100 pupils.

### McQuaid Student Derby Downs Champ Plans Med Training

Lanky 15-year-old Dick Rohrer, an honor roll pupil at McQuaid Jesuit High School, who spent 500 hours building a car, ran one of the fastest races in the history of Derby Downs, at Akron, Ohio, last Aug. 14 to win the 1055 All-American Soap Box Derby.

A champ at growing as well as racing, Dick gained 30 pounds in weight and eight inches in height in one year. Because of this, he scrapped the first car he built and turned out a newer and lighter model.

In the championship race, Dick swept across the finish line ahead of David Thayer, now 15, of Detroit and Albert Cobble, who is also 15, of Long Beach, Calif., giving Rochester its first title in 18 years of All-American competition.

IN DEFEATING the field of 154 champions from the United States, Canada, Alaska and Western Germany, Dick won the \$5,000 first prize scholarship awarded by Chevrolet Motor Division of General Motors.

A few days ago Dr. Henry D. Rohrer, popular dentist who resides at 402 Bonnie Brae Ave. and father of the champ reported Dick is planning a pre-medical school program at Georgetown University and will either become a physician or follow in his footsteps.

Rohrer's No. 119 blue racer sped to the fastest times of the day, with his best time of 27:12 seconds for the 97.5-foot course being one of the fastest ever recorded.

### Pope Names Msgr. Drew Domestic Prelate

MONSIGNOR DREW The Rt. Rev. Msgr. Bernard A. Drew, pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish, Rapid City, South Dakota, who will speak at the Masses in St. Charles Borromeo Church, Greece, Sunday, April 15 was raised to the rank of Domestic Prelate with the title of Right Reverend Monsignor by Pope Pius XII, last week.

A NATIVE OF Rochester, Monsignor Drew received the Papal Honor with three other priests of the Diocese of Rapid City. Announcement was made by Bishop William T. McCarthy, C.S.S.R., who received the appointments from the Vatican on April 5.

Monsignor Drew attended St. Andrew and St. Bernard Seminaries, St. Bonaventure College and Niagara University.

Ordained for the Diocese of Rapid City on Dec. 19, 1936, he served in parishes at Newell, Hermosa, Vivian and Draper before becoming pastor of the Rapid City parish on August 15, 1947.

Elevated with Monsignor Drew were: the Rev. John F. O'Hara of Hot Springs, who attended Niagara University; Rev. Aloysius B. Grady, Presbro and Rev. Francis P. Monaghan, Gregory.
