Miss Maxine Schlingman, drama director of Albertus Magnus College, New Haven, Conn., will be guest speaker at the banquet in the evening, highlighting the day's events. Formerly director of drama at St. Louis University and Trinity College, Washington, D. C., Miss Schlingman received a Master of Fine Arts degree from Yale University, School of Drama, and a Master of Arts degree from Marquette University, Milwaukee, Wis. At Albertus Magnus, she has directed "Skin Of Our Teeth," "Murder in the Cathedral," "Tidings Brought to Mary," "The Boy With a Cart," "Pygmalion," "She Directed 'Mary of Scotland,'" "The Beautiful People," "Arsenic and Old Lace" and "Green Grow the Lilacs" at St. Louis University.
