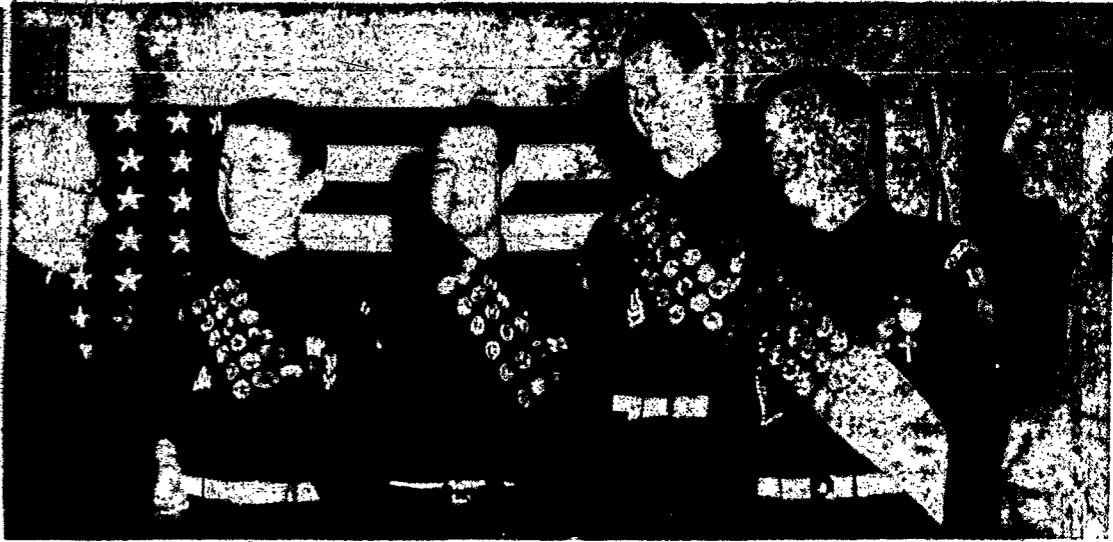
**Cub Scouts Slate
