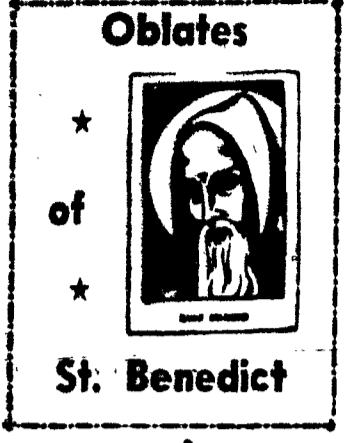

Metaphysics Paper Presented by Basilian

A paper on "Empiricisms and Varieties of Metaphysics" was read by the Rev. Robert G. Miller, C.S.B., Ph. D., native of Rochester, of the department of philosophy of Assumption University, Windsor, Ont. at the 60th annual meeting of the Michigan Academy of Science, Arts and Letters on March 24.

Father Miller is the son of Mr. and Mrs. William F. Miller, 179 Augustine St. The meeting was held in the Ruchman Building at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. "Metaphysics is not to be defended against its opponents, in the sense of adding some non-metaphysical criterion of its truth," said Father Miller. He added that no greater disservice could be done the philosophy of St. Thomas than to inject the Cartesian cogito into its normal human principation.

"One must continue to point out the primacy of being and the intelligible necessities which are present and visible in reality as contacted and grasped in each direct judgment of existence. A great service could be rendered to the opponents of metaphysics," said Father Miller, by showing them the necessity of disengaging Thomistic existential metaphysics from their supposedly univocal target. For the metaphysics of St. Thomas is derived from concrete existence through intellectual perception or insight, through analogical abstractive insight."

Empiricists, he added, should be intelligently and historically curious at St. Thomas' insistence that the principle or the beginning even of metaphysical knowledge is in the senses.
