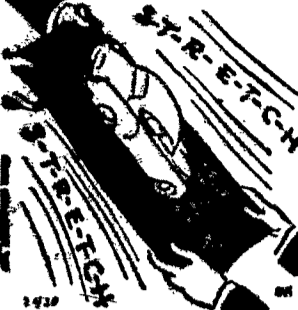

Seminary Lists Entrance Exam For Applicants

Entrance examinations for all diocesan students seeking admission to St. Andrew's Seminary next fall will be held at the Seminary on Buffalo Road, Saturday, May 26 at 1 p.m.

All new students applying for enrollment either in the High School or College departments of the Seminary must take this entrance examination, according to the rector, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Maynard A. Conwell.

Each candidate must present a letter of recommendation from his pastor prior to or on the day of the entrance test, the rector stated. Pastors may forward letters of recommendation to the rector in advance of the entrance examination. Application forms will not be issued to candidates in advance of the examination but will be filed under instruction at the Seminary, on May 26, according to Monsignor Conwell.
