George Robert Hogan, a senior at St. John Fisher College, was appointed to the position of public administration intern in the Executive Chamber, Office of the Secretary to the Governor of New York State. Selected through a nation-wide open-competitive examination, Hogan ranked 2nd on the examination with a score of 83.96. He will assume his duties on July 2.

Public administration internships were inaugurated by Governor Thomas E. Dewey in 1948. Twenty-five to 30 applicants are appointed annually for training as future state executives and are assigned to various departments. Hogan is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward J. Hogan of 10 Lake Ave. Lima, and a member of St. Rose Parish. He attended St. Rose School and was graduated from Lima High School in 1947.

While in high school, Hogan was president of his class in his junior and senior years; editor of the yearbook and of the school newspaper. He was sent to Boy's State in his junior year. He enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1948 and served as a recruiting specialist until September, 1952. While at St. John Fisher College, Hogan was on the dean's list; vice president of the senior class; a member of the Sodality and Mission Unit and also participated in school plays. He is married to the former Patricia A. Yonkovit of Ludington, Mich. A candidate for the degree of Bachelor of Science with a major in Social Science, Hogan anticipates receiving his degree on June 3. Mr. and Mrs. Hogan will make their home in Albany after July 2.

**Rock Lining Halts WaterHeaterRust**  
A principle long used in building bridges has proved itself just as valuable in the construction of water heaters for the home.  
This isn't so far-fetched as it sounds. In bridge building, when a steel shaft is sunk in water, it is encased with concrete. The steel alone would rust, but the concrete seals the corrosive water out.  
The sides and tops of some water heaters, the Coleman Heating Institute points out, are lined with a similar rock-like material that keeps the tanks from rusting. Tank bottoms are lined with vitreous enamel for rapid transfer of heat. The name "vit-rock" has been given to the process.

**Lantern Ready If Power Fails**  
Suitable for home emergency use as well as for outings, a new type of portable lantern carries its own supply of fuel in a can at its base. As an emergency light, it's designed for instant use when electric power fails.  
Each can of fuel is sold by the manufacturer to give about four hours of bright, white light under average temperature conditions. The lantern lights readily with a match. Sighting is similar to current models of the standard Coleman gasoline-pressure lantern used by campers, hunters, and fishermen.

**HOME OWNERS QUESTION BOX**  
Q-Is there any way to overcome binding when sawing wood?  
A-Binding is most likely to occur in long cuts, particularly if the wood is damp or green. The end of a screw driver or a wedge-shaped piece of wood should be inserted in the cut, after the saw. This will minimize binding.  
Q-I have a chicken coop that's built on top of wood posts. How can I insulate the floor of the coop?  
A-The insulation should be installed on the underside of the flooring. Lay mineral wool blankets between the floor joists with the capor barrier side next to the flooring. Chicken wire should be laid under the blankets and fastened to the joists by wood strips. The wire will hold the insulation in place.  
Q-What are the common causes of damp basement walls?  
A-There are three frequent causes. First, the bricks or cement blocks of the foundation may be faulty, or they may be joined in a faulty way. Second, there may be cracks in the wall that were formed as the building settled and uneven weight was placed on various parts of the foundation. Last, the pressure of water on the outside of the foundation may be so great that water is forced through the pores of the foundation.  
Q-My step railing is rusted. I'd like to paint it, but I'm afraid the rust will eat through the primer. Is there any kind of paint primer that will hold back the rust?  
A-Scrape off the loose particles of rust, then paint the metal with red lead. Give the red lead four or five days to dry. It can then be covered with enamel. The red lead will check the rust.
