Lake Placid — (Special) — Rochester has been selected as the site of the 20th annual convention of the Department of New York, Catholic War Veterans, to be held in May 1957.

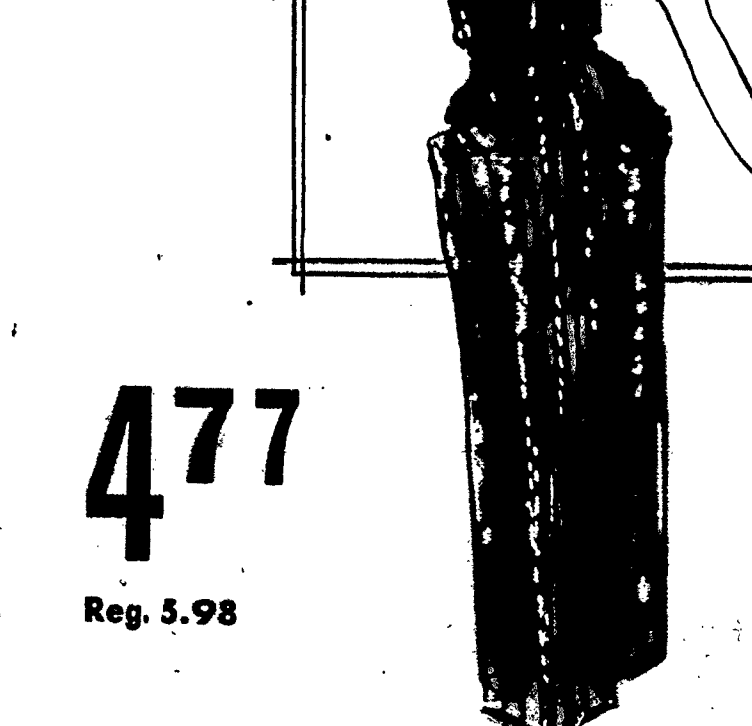
The announcement was made by John L. Driscoll, Monroe County Commander and delegate to the 1956 convention which concluded Sunday at Lake Placid.

Two resolutions submitted by Monroe County Chapter were adopted at this convention. One petitioned the Department of Justice to seek an injunction against the Daily Worker, and the other was a petition to withhold any further exchange of visits with Soviet government agents.

In another resolution delegates favored the establishment of a Foreign Service Academy where prospective U.S. foreign diplomats would be trained.
