Mount Saviour Monks Plan New Monastery

Six miles west of Elmira where the waters of the Chemung River go softly, a neat road sign points the way to the Benedictine Priory of Mt. Saviour.

The road ascends through dense woodland and on its left shoulder a buoyant brook like a laughing dog comes down to meet you. A clearance is gained on the bald rounded dome of the hill. A slender spire appears. Scattered cottages fill past and a large unpainted barn with a white cross affixed to its gable punctuates the route to the chapel, there another sign directs the visitor to the farmhouse which serves as living quarters for the Benedictines.

The community was having its afternoon recreation when I arrived. They graciously invited me to join them. Father Gregory Eorstedt, O.S.B., the superior was in charge, the prior, Father Damianus Winzen having gone to Rome. At the moment the monks with their grey denim work habits and close cropped heads resembled a sixteenth century woodcut — an embryonic Fleury or Einsiedeln. In the crowded chapter room they were holding council over plans for the permanent monastery. Drawings for the first structure which is to begin this summer were spread out before them.

FATHER GREGORY filled me in on the origin of Mt. Saviour. On March 28 it was five years since the first two monks arrived to take possession of the land. The first beginnings of this monastic experiment go back to sixth century Italy and St. Benedict who founded his school of Christian living at Monte Cassino. Another European abbey has a direct connection with Mt. Saviour — that of Maria Laach in the Rhineland. Father Dam-
