Contact must be made at the source of power. In religion, this is known as Apostolic Succession. A religion which starts today as a modern Christianity is too far away from Christ to receive His authority and His Power; even a church which started four hundred years ago is too distant from God Incarnate to be vested with His Commission. But it is possible for every Bishop and Priest in the church today through the Vicars of Christ to trace back their authority to Christ Himself.

Something new has recently happened in the Mission World: the Apostolic Succession was transmitted to a white bishop from a negro bishop. Bishop Bigirimwami of Nyundo, Africa, consecrated Bishop Perraudin, who after the ceremony, addressed the African Bishop as follows: "An old friend of mine wrote that the Church is above all races. That is not quite correct; the Church is in all races, at the heart of all races, uniting them from within. She is the only force in the world that can do that."

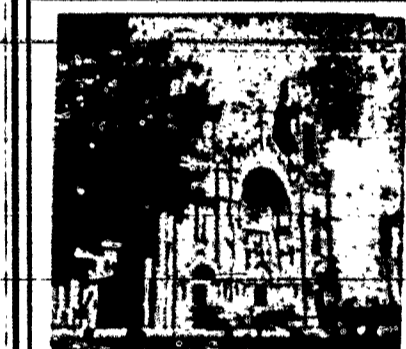
