**BOOK SHELF**

Two About Nuns  
By Sister Margaret Teresa  
Nazareth College

**BERNIE BECOMES A NUN**, by Sister Maria Del Rey. With more than 200 photographs by George Harris, Farrar, Strauss & Giroux, \$3.24. At Tucker's and all Catholic bookstores.  
**NUNS ARE REAL PEOPLE**, by Sister Mary Laurence, O.P. Newmann Press, Maryland, '56. 181 pp. \$3.00. Tucker's and all Catholic bookstores.

These two accounts of the religious life, the great Thru-way to God that Holy Mother Church has developed through the ages, are each excellent in their way and together pretty well cover the subject. One deals with the nun or Sister in the active life, the other with the cloistered religious. (Neither wastes time on invidious distinctions in the use of the term "nun," so popular with people who are trying to "cut down" religious life. Both recognize that the girl who wants to live totally for Our Lord to bring Him souls, is called to some special one out of a hundred orders or congregations all under the wing of the Church.)

**BERNIE BECOMES A NUN** is American to the nth degree, and distinguished in style — typical only of our best. Sister Maria Del Rey is a gifted and experienced reporter, a Margaret Bourke-White of the pen who entered Maryknoll and who did IN AND OUT OF THE ANDES, a book of undiminished popularity. Her **BERNIE** is pictured for Maryknoll but worked for any order or congregation engaged in the active life, and worded with American directness, with penetration, and beauty too.

**NUNS ARE REAL PEOPLE** sets itself to answer that protestant type of Catholic question, the invidiously blind question that omits two key words every time — Jesus Christ. The answer, I mean to say, is always just the realizing those two words. I could give you a poem, I could write you a song, I would never stop, I am never going to stop for all eternity! If I even briefly think that I might have been confronted with someone who held me back from this life, it is like "When I have thoughts that I may cease to be" — only more so.

**ONLY I AM** too busy with nicer music, like most nuns, who go about saying under their breath, "Oh, how come, how come—that it was I, that You let me! Not just my head and my hands, Lord! Thou knowest all things, Lord. Thou knowest that I love Thee — Bear with me, stay with me..."

Well — but as if incidentally, the book brings forward that very Person, that Total Answer, the Beloved Who descends ever and anon to the abysmal humiliation (so I think it) of having to speak for Himself! Having to ask for His first fruits, having to argue with Catholics for the devotion and espousal of His own creature, having sometimes to say to the little creature herself that He really isn't a risk, that His Church needs her help and he merits her life's love, and five times and a million times her life's love, that if she could live over and over again so as to live as long as humanly, and in each life vowed herself to Him by three vows, it wouldn't be half enough.

The little British book **NUNS ARE REAL PEOPLE** is addressed to a wider range of people, to that vast group who have more questions than they have answers of Christ, but who perhaps deserve to be answered. Christ did not run after the young man who turned away, but no doubt He would have answered, would have hungrily welcomed, questions from him.

All the stock questions are answered here, warmly, colloquially, and with chapter and verse, to that vast group who have more questions than they have answers of Christ, but who perhaps deserve to be answered.
