

Poet 'Frank Clare' Revealed As Nun

Dubuque, Iowa — (NC) — "Frank M. Clare," who wrote several volumes of poetry and whose works appeared in a number of nationally circulated magazines, has died here.

The pen name was used by Sister Mary Frances Clare, 80, a Visitation nun, who succumbed to a heart attack at Visitation convent here. She had been a member of the Sisterhood for 53 years and taught art at Visitation Academy here.

Rev. William J. Brien, newly ordained priest, and a nephew of Monsignor Brien, will be the Deacon of the Mass and Rev. Leo G. Schwab pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Church, Elmira, will be subdeacon.

Rev. Cassian Kirk O.F.M. of New York City will be the preacher at the Mass.

The girls' choir under the direction of Sister Mary Angela will sing at the Mass. Francis P. Lynch is organist.

FATHER BRIEN will be the celebrant of a Solemn High Mass of Thanksgiving the same morning at 8:45. At this Mass, Monsignor Brien will be the Archpriest, Rev. Robert J. Donovan will be deacon and Rev. Francis J. Erb will be subdeacon.

Monsignor Brien's first priestly assignment in 1916 was as assistant pastor at St. Patrick Cathedral, Rochester. He served on the faculty of Aquinas Institute for 16 years before his appointment as pastor of St. Patrick Church, Elmira in 1932. He became vicar forane or dean of Elmira deanery in 1945.
