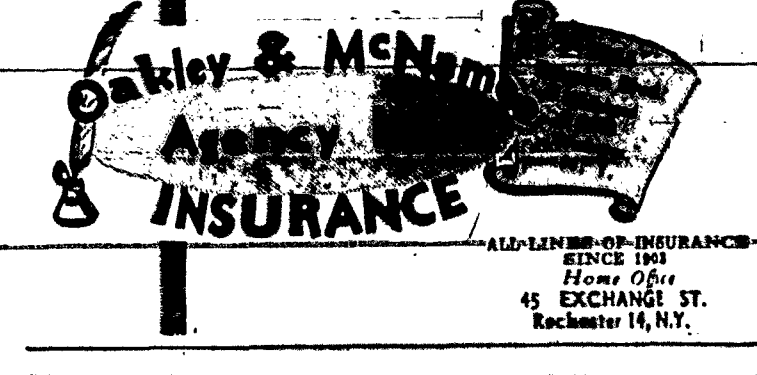

Remodeling Job On 8-Room Home Begins With Roof

If you have a bank account that won't allow you to pamper your whims, but you're fond of the gracious livability of the old or house combined with the time-saving conveniences of modern home design, you're much like Robert F. Wurth Jr. of Chestnut, Ill.

Wurth and his family did something about it. They tracked down this solid old eight-room house, and bought and remodeled it. Total cost of the house, plus extensive modernization, was less than half the cost of a new house of comparable size.

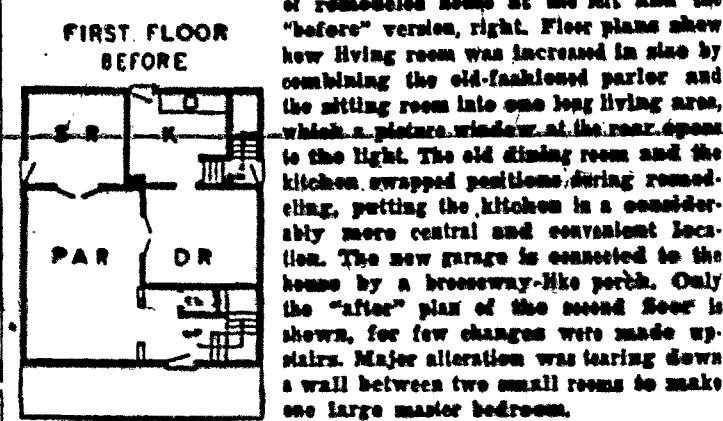
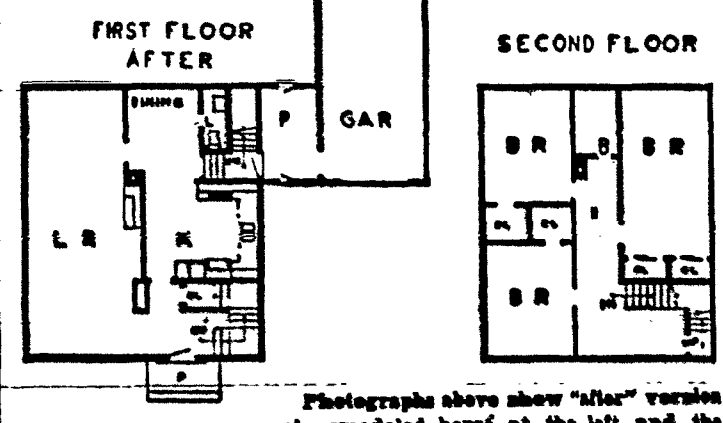
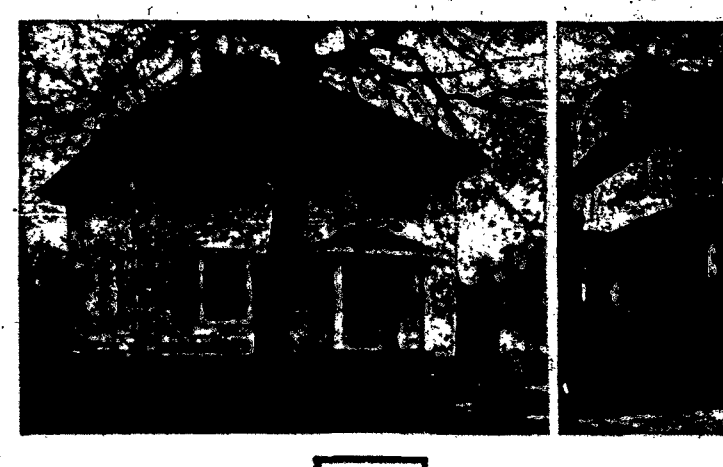
Like most successful remodeling jobs, this one began with the roof. The third-floor gables, coupled with the huge front porch, advertised the building's Victorian origin. The gables were removed, presenting a clean, modern roof line.

Porch Removed

The front porch also came off. It had darkened the front rooms, and since the street in front of the house had changed from a dirt road to a busy thoroughfare in the past half century, the porch was no longer a pleasant, restful place to enjoy the air.

The porch was replaced by a small entrance shelter styled in Williamsburg tradition. The roof of the porch was sloped to match the main roof as was the roof of the new attached garage at the side of the house. The roofs of the porch, garage, and main building were covered with colorful asphalt shingles. The roof color performs the valuable function of integrating old and new construction.

The handsome six-panel Colonial pine door at the main entrance, the window shutters, and the garage door were painted in the same attractive trim color, complementing the roof color and contrasting pleasantly with the white siding.



Photographs above show "after" version of remodeled home at the left and the "before" version, right. Floor plans show how living room was increased in size by combining the old-fashioned parlor and the sitting room into one large living area, which is a picture window at the rear opens to the light. The old dining room and the kitchen swapped positions during remodeling, putting the kitchen in a considerably more central and convenient location. The new garage is connected to the house by a breezeway-like porch. Only the "after" plan of the second floor is shown, for few changes were made upstairs. Major alteration was tearing down a wall between two small rooms to make one large master bedroom.
