

Vice Principal, Assistant Superior Named At Aquinas

Appointment of the Rev. Leon Hart, C.S.B., as vice principal of Aquinas Institute, and the Rev. W. Oscar Regan, C.S.B., as assistant superior of the Basilian Fathers who staff the boys' high school was announced today.

Appointments to St. John Fisher College and Aquinas were made by the Very Rev. George E. Fahiff, C.S.B., Toronto, superior general of the Basilian Fathers.

Father Hart, a native Rochesterian, is an alumnus of Aquinas and has been a member of the teaching staff for two years. He also taught at Aquinas while a seminarian.

Father Regan, director of the English department, came to Rochester in 1937 when the Basilian Fathers assumed direction of Aquinas.

26th Anniversary Of First Mass Set At Holy Angels

Twenty-sixth anniversary of the First Mass celebrated at Holy Angels Convent, 1826 Winton Road North will be observed by the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity on Monday, July 9.

The Sisters arrived on June 16, 1830 and stayed at the Sisters of St. Joseph Motherhouse until the former farmhouse on Winton Road was ready for occupancy.

The frame building was to have been a temporary residence but the nuns are still housed there and they point out the need after 26 years for a new Monastery.

TWO OF THE original six Sisters are with the community, two others have died and two are in the Buffalo Monastery of the order. The Sisters conduct the Holy Angels Home for Girls.

St. Theodore's To Break Ground For Church, School

Ground breaking for a new church and a new school building in St. Theodore Parish, Spencerport Road, Gates on Sunday, July 8, at 2:30 p.m. will culminate 19 years of planning according to the Rev. Raymond J. Epping, pastor.

The turning of the earth will mark the beginning of creation of a church edifice to seat 700 persons and an eight-room school building to house the 300 children in the parish school conducted by the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Edward M. Lorscheider is architect for the new buildings.

ARRANGEMENTS for the ceremony Sunday and a parish picnic to follow are in the hands of the Rev. John Steger, assistant pastor and General Chairman Charles Lechner and Joseph Morrow. Reservations for 600 persons have been made.

Father Epping took charge of St. Theodore Parish in 1937 succeeding the late Rev. John J. Baier, former pastor of St. John the Evangelist Church, Greece who founded the parish in 1924.

The parish celebrated its silver jubilee in December of 1949 and was canonically erected Dec. 8, 1924, incorporated Jan. 6, 1925.

Laying of the cornerstones of the first combination church-school building took place July 12, 1925 and the building was dedicated Oct. 25 of that year.

Due to expanding home-building programs in the parish, necessitating the new church and school planned over a 19 year period by Father Epping, he said.

Mass Saturday For Red Victims

Solemn Mass for Yugoslav victims of communism will be offered Saturday, July 7, at St. Anthony of Padua Church, Rochester, at 7:30 a.m.

Immigrants from Yugoslavia have arranged the Mass to commemorate the 11th anniversary of the Red massacre of 13,000 Yugoslav soldiers following Tito's communist coup in that nation.
