## Khrushchev 'Independence' Maneuver To Take In West

Having received extensive publicity for their alleged "independence," the Communist parties of the Western world are now using that "independence" obediently to follow Moscow's lead.

Palmiro Togliatti, general secretary of the Communist Party of Italy, led the procession of Western Communist leaders in asking for an explanation from Khrushchev and Company concerning the failure of the present Soviet leaders to act against Stalin's crimes while he was still in power. Now, in July 3, Togliatti leads the parade in "accepting" the explanation given by the Communist party of the Soviet Union — although, when examined, it is no more an explanation than was previously given by Khrushchev.

THAT STATEMENT of the Soviet leaders, once its extensive verbiage is analyzed, merely says that Stalin was too powerful to do anything about him. A deadly silence is preserved concerning the participation of Khrushchev and his colleagues in Stalin's excesses. Not a word appears about Khrushchev's own direction of the liquidation of the Ukrainian Communist Kosior, now listed among those falsely accused. And yet Togliatti on July 3 gives his "unreserved approval" to the direction of recent Soviet policy!

On July 6, the Central Committee of the French Communist Party unanimously declared that it was "fully satisfied" with Moscow's explanation. It "warmly approved the resolution of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union that shows how the cult of the personality of Stalin has been surmounted in the USSR." On the very day, the Soviet newspaper Pravda was resurrecting that cult in a new guise. It declared emphatically for one-party dictatorship. It asserted that in Soviet Russia "the Communist Party has been and will be the only master of the minds, and thoughts, the spokesman, leader, and organizer of the people in their entire struggle for Communism."

Going even beyond that, it quoted Lenin as having set down the rule that there must be "iron discipline at work, with absolute subordination — to the will of one person, at work." It requires no extensive study to understand that these words of Lenin led to the excesses of Stalinism, which are inherent in the Soviet Socialist system.

Two days before this statement Eugene Dennis, general secretary of the Communist Party of the United States, in the Daily Worker of July 4, placed himself beside Togliatti and the French Communist party in "accepting" the explanation given by Khrushchev and his colleagues. It is unfortunate that this declaration did not receive the same notice in the general press that Dennis' previous show of "independence" had received.

"In my opinion," Dennis states, "the resolution of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union goes a long way in explaining what has become known as the growth of the cult of the individual and the unforgivable violations of Socialist legality and principles that took place in here."

### Rabbi Explains Catholic Conduct Sometimes Repels Jews From Church

Notre Dame, Ind. — (Special) — A priest who is an authority on Catholic-Jewish relations has asked Catholics to re-examine their relationships with Jews.

Writing in the current issue of THE AVE MARIA, national Catholic weekly magazine, Father Victor J. Donovan, C.P., of West Hartford, Conn., pointed out that he does not "wish to insinuate that Catholics as such are anti-Semitic. But there are grounds for serious concern on our part. Our words and actions are being used against us."

"THE ENEMIES of the Church," he says, "are more alert than we are to the possible distortion of our careless talk, our social exclusiveness, and our religious selfishness. It is now time the charges against us should be given our most serious consideration."

Father Donovan said that he became interested in the relationship between Catholics and Jews when a friendly Rabbi "told me that the secret of his success in keeping the people coming to his synagogue was attributable in no small measure to the help given him by Catholics, both from among the clergy and the laity."

The Rabbi explained that he had several times noted a member of his synagogue drifting toward Catholicism, but he invariably found that "the shock of meeting anti-Semitism in some form or other drove the person back to his own religion."

Upon investigation, Father Donovan found many examples of Jews who had been repelled from the Church by the words or actions of individual Catholics.

"OUR PEOPLE," Father Donovan explained, "do not need to root out of their lives any positive forms of violent anti-Semitism. What they need most is to be made conscious of the tremendous influence that their words and actions have upon their Jewish neighbors."

## 5,126 U.S. Missionaries Serve Overseas

Washington — (NC) — For the first time in the history of the Catholic Church in the United States the number of missionaries in this country serving outside its boundaries has exceeded 5,000.

This is revealed by Bishop Fulton J. Sheen, national director of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith, in his preface to the new edition of "U.S. Catholic Overseas Missionary Personnel," to be published in August.

THE BOOKLET presents complete information on the statistics of missionaries who are citizens of the United States, serving outside the United States, as of December 31, 1955.

A total of 5,126 are fulfilling the divine mandate: "Go teach ye all nations." This figure represents about five percent of the total number of missionaries serving under the Sacred Congregation for the Propagation of the Faith. However, "no other country in the world gives so much to the support of the missions as does the United States," Bishop Sheen writes.

"SIXTY-FIVE percent of all that the Holy Father receives from his Pontifical Society for the Propagation of the Faith for distribution comes from the United States," he says.
