HOME OWNERS QUESTION BOX

Q—We're thinking of installing a storage wall to supplement the closet space in our small house. Can this be a "do-it-yourself" project, or must I hire a carpenter?

A—Building a storage wall isn't too difficult for the average home handyman if he makes use of ponderosa pine kitchen cabinets and louvered doors. Rome (NC) — Father John Baptist Janssens, General of the Society of Jesus, has left Rome for Munich, Germany, for a period of rest. He was said to be very tired and in poor health.

Father Janssens, who was elected head of the Jesuits some ten years ago, was born in Malines, Belgium, December 22, 1889.

Papal Relief Aides Cite U.S. Help

Vatican City (NC) — Msgr. Ferdinando Baldelli, president of the Pontifical Relief Organization (PRO) has expressed his gratitude to two American officials here for the help the U. S. government has given to the organization.

The two Americans who visited PRO headquarters here are Peter Grimm, new director in Italy for the U. S. Operations Mission, which directs the foreign aid program in Italy, and Joseph McMurray, commissioner of housing in the executive department of New York State.

They were greeted by Msgr. Baldelli, Msgr. Andrew P. Landi, representative in Italy of Catholic Relief Services, National Catholic Welfare Conference, and other officials of the PRO.

Msgr. Baldelli said that the U. S. government's assistance has enabled the PRO to take effective action on a broad national scale in helping Italian needy and in rebuilding slum areas. The American officials told the priests that they would inform U. S. organizations of the notable work being done by the PRO.

Priest Appointed To Prison Probe

Hartford, Conn. (RNSS) — Gov. Abraham A. Ribicoff has named the Rev. John L. Bonn, S.J., widely known authority on prison guidance, to a five-member citizens' committee which will investigate conditions at the Connecticut State Prison in Wethersfield.

Father Bonn is a member of the faculty at Fairfield (Conn.) University, and the author of "The Gates of Danemora," an account of prison life.

The Governor appointed the committee following a non-violent sit-down strike by half of the prison's inmates, the second such incident at the prison in less than six months. Mr. Ribicoff asserted that the citizens' committee will have a free hand

CARE OF YOUR FLOORS CAN BE AN EASY TASK!

Resilient floors can be kept beautiful with a minimum of simple care. With occasional attention, using good quality cleaners and waxes, floors will stay in good condition and give many extra years of wear.

Studies made by resilient floor manufacturers show that most people overwash and overwax their floors, thus making unnecessary work for themselves without really benefitting their floors. It is the opinion of many experts that more floors are worn out by scrubbing than by actual wear.

By following a few simple rules, the homemaker can be assured of getting the maximum beauty and wear from her floors with the least amount of work.

Cleaning And Waxing A damp mop will remove light soiling. However, when a complete washing is indicated use warm water and a mild cleaner, such as Nairn Linoleum Cleaner. For stubborn smudges fine steel wool will do the trick, and for marks from rubber heels use a cloth moistened in household cleaning fluid (except Asphalt tile). Rinse the surface of the floor thoroughly with clear clean water and allow to dry completely before applying wax. For best waxing results apply a light coat of water emulsion type wax, such as Nairn Self-Polishing Wax. Allow wax to dry thoroughly, then apply a second very light coat of wax and let dry. Where a high luster is required, buff the floor with a wax buff.

The so-called water emulsion type waxes have been on the market for many years and are well accepted as the preferred finish for all floor coverings. They do not contain any solvents

that are harmful or injurious to floor coverings and are safer because they are less slippery. It is also interesting to note that when it comes time to strip off old, discolored wax and renew the floor, water emulsion waxes are easier to remove.

Harsh Cleaners Avoid using strong soaps or abrasive cleaning compounds, as alkaline soaps may soften the surface, and abrasive cleaners may roughen the natural smoothness of many floor coverings. Do not apply liquid, plastic or other hard finishes to any smooth surface floor covering. These materials scratch quickly and will give a shabby appearance in areas of constant wear. They also tend to yellow the colors and soften the surface of the floor as they age. Also, they are extremely difficult to remove without causing permanent damage to the floor covering.

It is important to remember that broken casters and small metal slivers, indent floor coverings and may damage them permanently. Equip furniture with large surface casters glides or furniture cups.

Asphalt Tile Where the flooring is asphalt tile the use of cleaners or waxes containing solvents such as benzene, turpentine, naphtha, etc., must be avoided, as they will soften the composition of the tile and cause the colors to run, permanently injuring the material.

China Communists Invade Burma Mission Area

The strip of north Burma invaded by Chinese Communist troops forms the edge of mission territories in charge of Columbian priests and Italian missionaries of SS. Peter and Paul (PIME).

From the reports available it does not appear that the area invaded includes any mission residences.

BURMA'S FAR north comprises the Prefecture of Bhamo, stated by 22 Columbian Fathers, 26 Franciscan Missionaries of Mary Sisters and four Columbian Sisters. Msgr. Patrick Usher is Prefect Apostolic. The adjoining diocese of Kentung has 22 Missionaries of SS. Peter and Paul, 3 Sisters of Charity and 26 Sisters of Reparation. All of these communities are from Italy.

The Most Rev. Ferdinando Gucliena is Bishop of Kentung.

Minor incidents occurred previously in the jungle areas along the vaguely defined border between north east Burma and China. Last February a Burma-China conference was held at the border to negotiate for a definite line.
