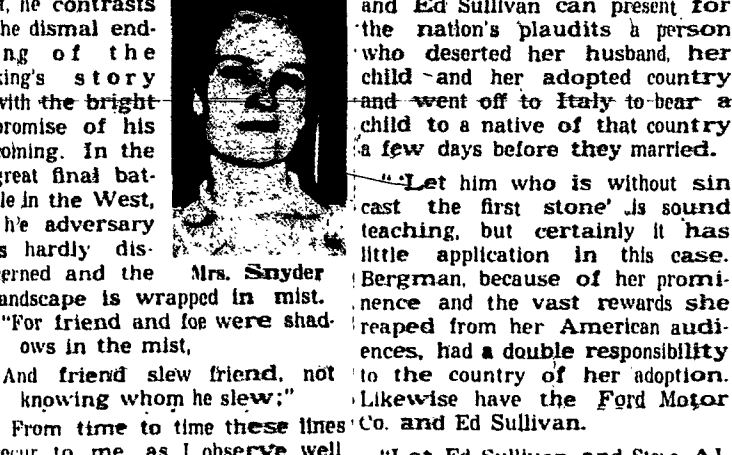
Not altogether to our surprise, we find that such sports are included in the training program which, please God, she will take in a few weeks.
