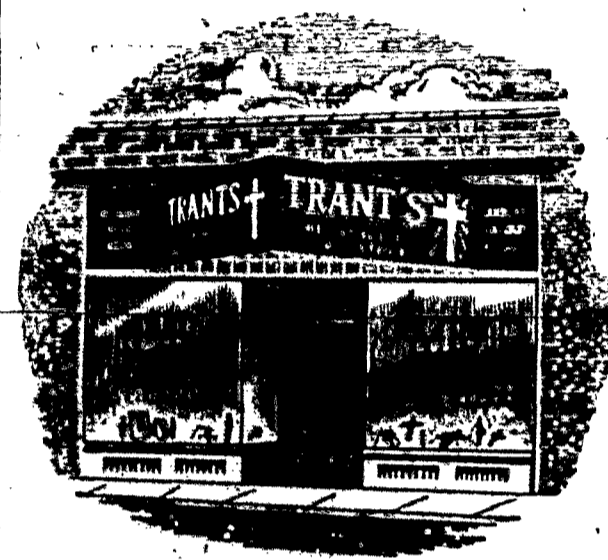
**NEGRO CARMELITE**

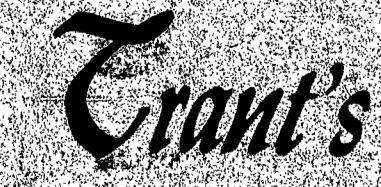

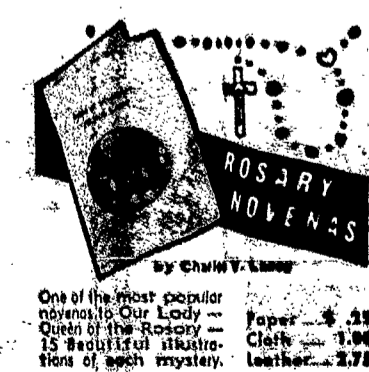
