

Bishop Cites 3 Workers' CYO Record Of 25 Years

Three workers, who participated in every campaign held by the Columbus Youth Organization for the past 25 years, were praised for their work last night at the CYO Silver Jubilee Anniversary membership drive kickoff.

The beginning of the 1956-57 drive, scheduled to run through Tuesday, Oct. 16, started with a dinner, held in the Columbus Civic Centre, attended by 200 workers, with His Excellency Bishop Kearney as keynote speaker.

The Bishop cited Mrs. Joseph R. Kaseman, 30 Fountain St., of Blessed Sacrament Parish; Helen Costello, secretary to the director of Catholic Charities, and William T. Nolan, general secretary of Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Rochester.

The Bishop, honorary chairman of the drive for the 19th year, was introduced by Edwin G. Bauer, general chairman. Others at the speakers' table were Rt. Rev. Msgr. Arthur E. Raligan, diocesan director of Catholic Charities; Rev. Eugene H. McFarland, CYO director;

At a special gifts session, held last Tuesday in the Columbus Civic Centre, Crowley announced that his group has achieved 75 per cent of its goal of 2,000 members. Mrs. Kaseman, in the 25 years she has been active in the CYO (until two years ago the Columbus Youth Assn.) drive, has always served as a captain. Miss Costello has assisted Nolan, who has acted as membership secretary. Nolan was first campaign director.

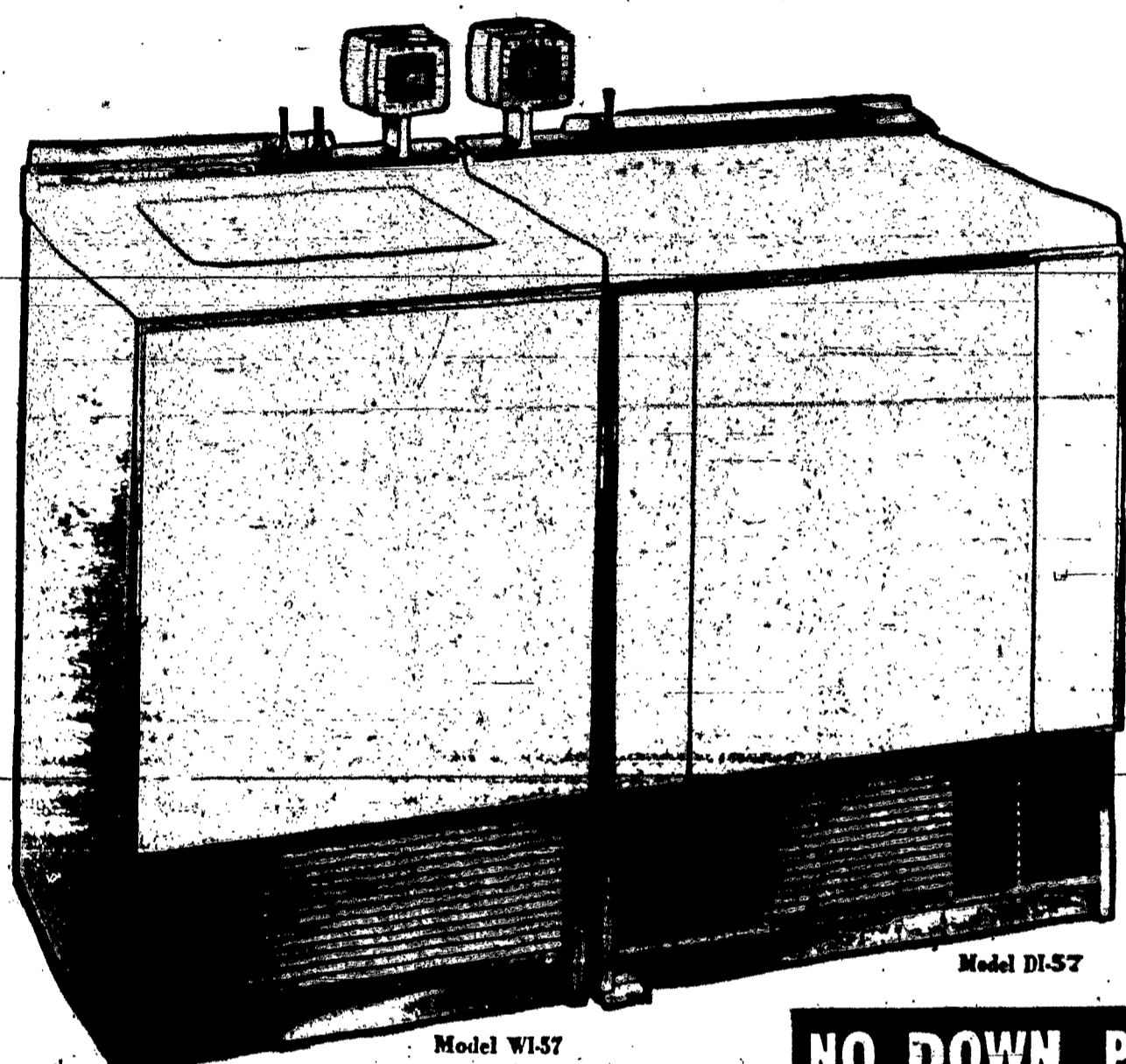

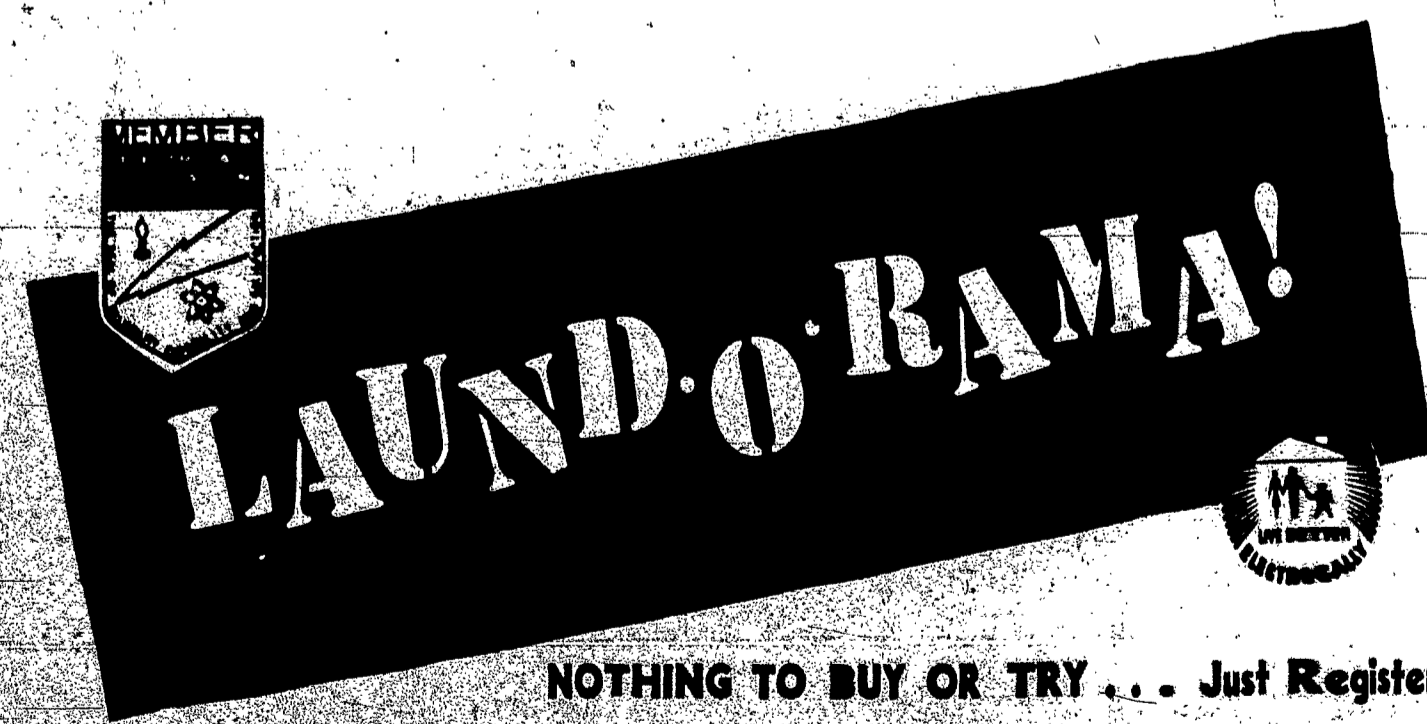
