New Parish In Auburn Named For Sacred Heart

Auburn—"Sacred Heart" was chosen as the name of the new parish to be established in the Melrose Area of Owaseo, just south of the Auburn city line, the Rev. Raymond J. Wahl, pastor, announced today.

His Excellency Bishop Kearney commenting on this title observed that this would be appropriate in as much as this year marked the 100th anniversary of the extension of the feast of the Sacred Heart to the entire Church.

His Excellency cited the Encyclical of Pope Pius XII "Haurietis Aquas" as showing how devotion to the Sacred Heart is a "true synthesis of the whole Christian religion."

IN THIS letter the Holy Father states that "the essential elements of this devotion, namely, acts of love and reparation rendered to the infinite love of God for man — far from being defiled by materialism and superstition — constitute a form of piety which perfectly carries out a true and spiritual devotion, as was foretold by the Savior himself."

"Moved by an ardent desire to set effective defenses against the evil designs of the enemies of God and the Church, and to return families and nations to the path of the love of God and neighbor, we do not hesitate to intensify the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus," the Pope wrote.

Further plans for the parish have not yet been formulated, but a definite program is expected to be announced in the near future. Meanwhile various preparations are progressing for the establishment of this new parish.
