## St. Theodore Parish Drive Exceeds Goal By \$50,000, Building Underway

Pledges totaling \$182,555 — more than \$50,000 beyond the minimum goal — were reported last week in the fund drive for new church and school buildings at St. Theodore Parish, Gates. Construction of the buildings is already underway.

The Rev. Raymond J. Epping, pastor, expressed appreciation to parishioners and the campaign committee for this "splendid tribute of loyalty to God and His Church."

More than 200 men of the parish — conducted a two-hour parish-wide canvass on Sunday afternoon, Nov. 11, for three-year pledges toward the new buildings, which will replace present frame church and school structures made inadequate by the increasing community population. A minimum goal of \$125,000 was sought.

**THE NEW CHURCH**, designed to seat nearly 700 persons, will be joined at the rear by an eight-classroom school. The buildings are being erected just west of the present parish structures on Spencerport Road, on the 38-acre parish plot.

His Excellency, Auxiliary Bishop Casey addressed the campaign committee at a kickoff dinner Saturday, Nov. 10, in the Powers Hotel. The workers held a victory rally last Thursday night in St. Helen School hall.

Heading the campaign committee were Harold Blakely and Harold Ehnman, co-chairmen, with Bernard Ayotte and Herbert Zimmerman as vice-chairmen. Chairman of the advanced gifts committee

was Max Russer. Joseph Lynch headed the advisory committee, and Michael Brodner was chairman of the survey committee.

Assisting in the direction of the campaign was Foley Associates Inc., a Rochester fund-raising organization.
