#### Commercial Airline Offers Clergy Rate

Washington, D. C. -- (RNS) --Bornanza Airlines of Las Vegas, Newada, has become the first contamercial airline to file a passenger tariff with the Civil Aeronautics Board here offering reduced rates to elergymen.

The tariff provides that clergymern will be able to buy tickets on a "space available" basis for 50 per cent of the one-way fare. The airline is a small "feeder" carrier. It serves a number of cities in New Mexico, Arizona, Newada and California, providing them with connecting service to major transcontinental air termi-
