

# Toronto Hockey Teams Meet Here For Benefit Of Hungarian Relief

The Toronto Hockey League will meet here today to discuss the relief of Hungarian refugees. The meeting will be held at the Toronto Y. M. C. A. at 11:30 a. m. The league consists of the Toronto Maple Leafs, Toronto St. Michael's Majors and Toronto Marlboros.

The task of our office is to settle these Hungarian refugees in the Toronto area. We must have housing, clothing and food for them until they have been settled and a job secured for them. If sickness comes, it is our responsibility to provide them with the proper care.

These Hungarians are not eligible for public support since they are not citizens. We ask you to aid us in their adjustment. At the present time, the Catholic Charities has a \$3,000 hotel bill to pay and no day passes but that we are called upon to advance the one month's rent for another new family that has just arrived.

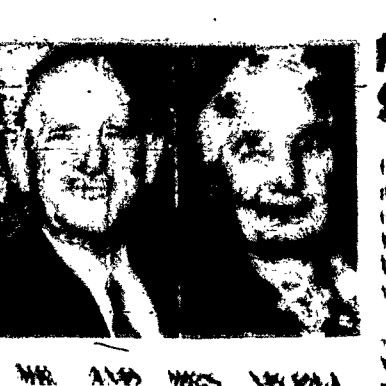
