Work Of Missionaries Described At Aquinas

The work of the modern missionary was described by two Oblates of Mary Immaculate to the students of Aquinas Institute in a mission assembly last Monday.

Rev. Thomas Brown, O.M.I., an Aquinas graduate of 1944 and son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Brown of St. Thomas Parish, and the Rev. Martin Walsh, O.M.I. of Buffalo outlined the work of the Oblates in the Arctic where Father Brown's brother, the Rev. Bernard Brown is stationed.

The Rev. John M. Wilson, C.S.B., moderator of Aquinas mission activities, presented the missionaries a check for \$200 on behalf of the student body.

Highlights of the visit was the appearance of "Prince", an Arctic husky dog, used by the missionaries to pull the sleds across the vast reaches of snow and ice. Father Brown revealed that in the Arctic missions hardships and dangers are ever present; one recent year saw three Oblate missionaries of the North lose their lives as martyrs to duty.
