Juniors at Nazareth College received their school rings at a formal ceremony April 4 at student hour. The entire student body and the faculty were present.

THE NAZARETH RING is an amethyst in an antique green-gold setting. Around the stone are the words, Sillium Collegii Nazareth Roffensis and on either side of the amethyst the seal of the college is engraved; which includes a wreath of laurel, significant of academic honor, two books with antique lamp thereon, and above the lamp, a Cross. About the upright beam of the Cross are the words, Lumen in Christo, the college motto.

General chairman of the ceremony was Ann Reed, assisted by Aureli Vall, decorations; Jane Donnelly, Helen Calnan and Joyce Mooney, invitations; and Bonnie Blanchard, program.
