### College Head At Affiliation Breakfast Urges Womanly Qualities In Activities

More than 200 members of the Ladies of Charity attended the 15th annual Corporate Communion and Affiliation last Sunday in the Little Flower chapel at Dunn Memorial. The Rev. Hubert A. Bisky, Moderator and the celebrant of the Mass and conducted the affiliation ceremonies. The Very Rev. John F. Murphy, C.S.B., president of St. John Fisher College, Rochester, was guest speaker at the breakfast that followed in Mark Twain Hotel.

"WOMAN IS a physical, cultural and spiritual Mother of mankind. By all means let women enter into every area of activity but let them bring to these arenas, qualities that are womanly. The world is affected and benefited by a womanly, energetic and dynamic woman. It isn't thoughtful, compassionate and holy enough. These things, you must bring it. Make your will not succeed, but you will be judged for all eternity by the way you try."

Referring to the troubled conditions of the world of today, Father Murphy said, "The great tragedy of the world is not the amount of pain and suffering that is current. The tragedy is that it is mostly wasted."

REMINDING HIS listeners of their duties, the speaker continued, "As the role of the artist is to take canvas and paint and breathe life into it in a beautiful picture, the role of the farmer is to plant seeds and foster them to grow and harvest, the role of the educator is to guide and direct human minds along the pathways of Truth that leads to God—so your role as a Lady of Charity is to take human suffering, lift it in hands that are tender, dress it with lives that are degenerated, enrich it with the in-crease of prayer—and offer it to God Almighty."

Father Murphy said in conclusion, "As a Lady of Charity, your role is to guide and direct human minds along the pathways of Truth that leads to God—so your role as a Lady of Charity is to take human suffering, lift it in hands that are tender, dress it with lives that are degenerated, enrich it with the in-crease of prayer—and offer it to God Almighty."
