Among Women Sacred Heart Enthronement

The Spiritual Development Committee of our Diocesan Council of Catholic Women has undertaken a project to encourage the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in every Catholic home. Mrs. Audrey Culhane, diocesan chairman, has sent me some Mrs. Snyder excellent literature on this practice.

Appropriately starting in this month of June, the Diocesan Committee advises that plans for the spread of the enthronement project will continue through the summer.

WE MIGHT suggest to those organizations which have had their last business meeting for the season that the Enthronement Project be planned during the summer months and that the project be introduced at the first autumn meetings.

As Mrs. Culhane points out in her bulletin to deaconry chairmen, "We have chosen the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in the home because it seems to fill such a great need today. We must sanctify the family and sanctify society. Today many things make it more difficult for the home to be what God intended it to be, namely a holy and sacred place."

Then after listing some of the forces militating against a good home life, the diocesan chairman continues, "So the special graces and blessings of the Sacred Heart are needed more than ever."

The National Center of the Enthronement is listed as that of the Fathers of the Sacred Heart, Washington, D. C., and I assume that the mimeographed instructions which Mrs. Culhane sent to me were prepared under their direction. The actual enthronement ceremony is a very beautiful one and is conducted in the home by a priest.

Listed as necessary preparations for the Ceremony of the Enthronement are the following: 1. Obtain a picture or statue of the Sacred Heart. This should be as beautiful as possible; 2. Decide where in the home it will be enthroned. It should receive a place of prominence; 3. Place the picture or statue on the altar or throne should be placed. This will be a table covered with

a white cloth and holding two vases of flowers and two blessed candles. A bottle of Holy Water is also necessary and is placed on the table; 4. On another smaller table nearby should be placed the picture or statue to be enthroned.

UNDER THE heading of desirable practices are added the following: 1. The whole family should attend Mass and receive Holy Communion together in the morning; 2. The day should be observed as a special family Feast Day; (Dinner, therefore, should be something extra); 3. Relatives and friends may be invited; 4. A party, in the form of refreshments, should be had after the ceremony.

A certificate of enthronement may be framed and placed in a place of prominence to serve as a constant reminder of the consecration of the family to the Sacred Heart and of our obligations.

Mrs. Culhane also sent along a copy of the ceremonial of the Enthronement and a list of recommended practices for families which have enthroned the Sacred Heart in their home.
