## Cardinal Condemns Vote For Socialists

Milano, Belgium — (NC) — It would be "gravely illicit" for a Catholic to vote for the Socialist or Liberal parties in Belgium's forthcoming general elections, according to the Cardinal Van Roey, Archbishop of Malines.

Cardinal van Roey said his restrictions are based on the fact that the Roman Catholic religion is systematically hindered and obstructed in its institution and influence by the present government not only in Belgium but in the Belgian Congo as well.

Belgium's present Socialist-Liberal coalition government has been openly opposed to government aid to Church-operated schools, both in the home country and in the Congo.
