retarial science, modern office practice, and stenographic office machines.

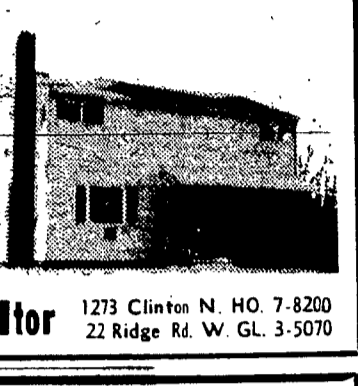
