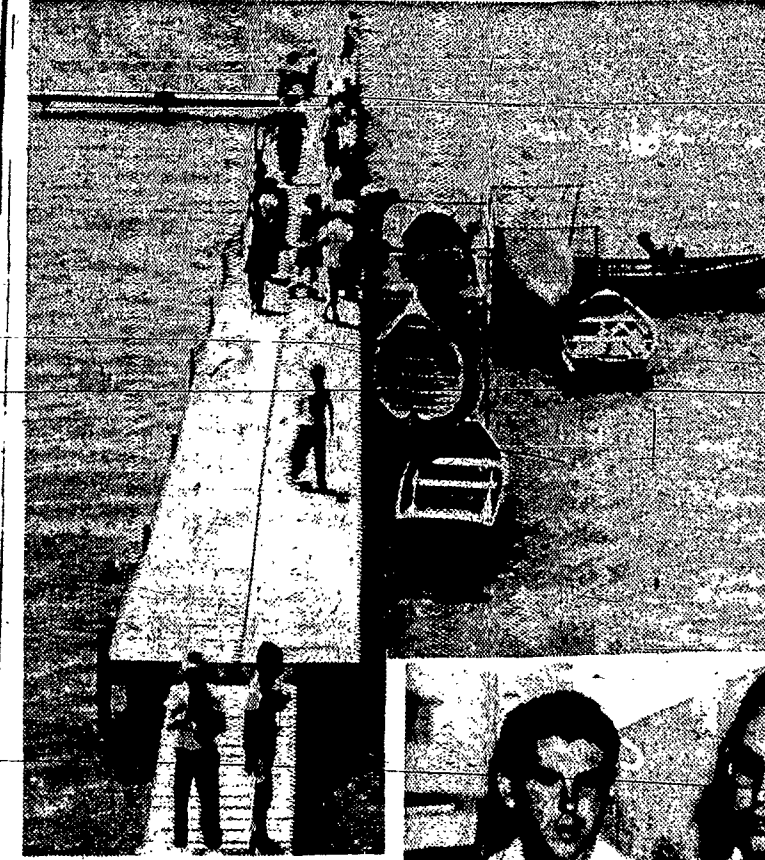

Topics discussed were tentative plans for a rummage sale to raise funds for putting the message of Fatima on television.

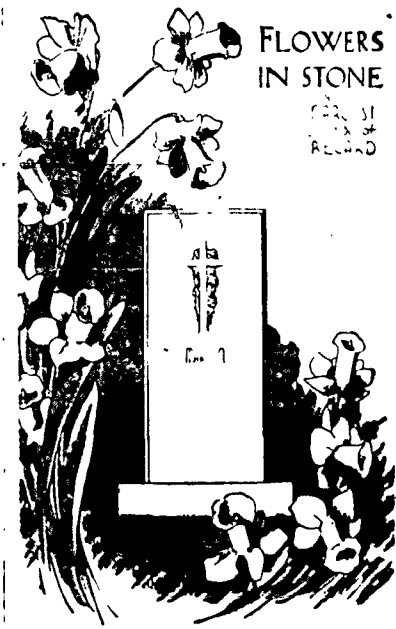
Plans were also formulated for showing a film of Our Lady of Fatima on Aug. 15, the Feast of the Assumption.
