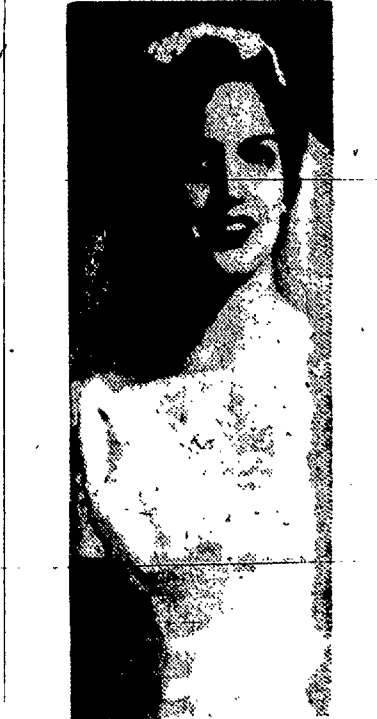

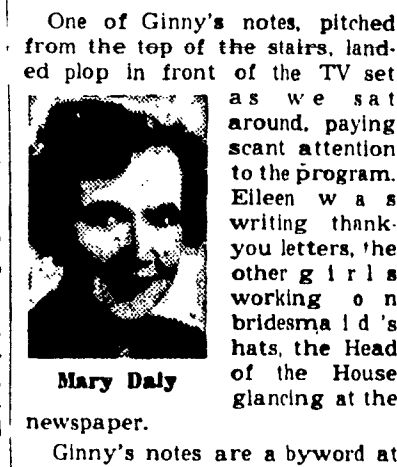
Season Ticket Drive To Open At Catholic Theatre Picnic
