Priest, Convert From Judaism

'Jews Changing On Christ'

London — (NC) — Some Jews are changing their attitude toward Christ, an American priest who is a convert from Judaism said at a conference here.

Father John M. Oesterreicher, founder and director of the Institute of Jewish-Christian Studies of Seton Hall University, Newark, N.J., said that it used to be that the name of Christ was never mentioned in a Jewish home.

BUT HE NOTED that in recent years, Martin Buber, a Jewish philosopher, had written of Christ as "My Great Brother," and that another Jewish authority, Montefiore, had described Our Lord as "a great prophet who bent down to the poor and the lowly."

Father Oesterreicher explained that this new attitude could not be called typical of modern Jews, but that it appears to be an increasing one.

Speaking at the Convocation of the Daughters of Our Lady of Zion, he mentioned the remark of Pope Pius XI that spiritually all Catholics are Semites.

Father Oesterreicher supplemented it by quoting widely from the Church's liturgy. He said Christ was "the Bridge" between Jews and Christians, and that Catholics must see Jews as their brethren.

HE CRITICIZED the attitude shown in one printed version of the Stations of the Cross which refers to "those wicked Jews" as a "complete reversal of the mystery of the Redemption." The Sacred Congregation of Rites has ruled that the adjective "perfidis" which the Church uses in the Prayer for the Jews on Good Friday, can be translated as "unbelieving" rather than "perfidious," he pointed out in reply to a question.

Father Oesterreicher also gave a talk at the Newman International Center, headquarters of the Newman Association for University graduates.

He said that as regards the Jewish attitude toward Christianity, the walls were "indeed crumbling but this does not mean that there is a movement of Jews towards the Church."

Many barriers still have to be overcome, he said perhaps the most important being the rigid monotheism of the Jews which prevented their accepting the mystery of the Incarnation.

Jews in history have suffered more than their share of persecution and this is inclined to give them a distorted view of Christ, he said. Christian prejudices have indeed

very often prevented conversions.

He asked: "If we were to examine ourselves on meeting a Jew, what would we find to be our predominant reaction? Disgust or love and compassion? Are Jews to us the living witnesses of the wonderful ways of God—or merely users?"

Iowa State Prisoners Catholics Rank Confirmed In Chapel Gain In Zurich

Fort Madison, Iowa — (NC) — The chapel at Iowa State Penitentiary here was filled with an overflow crowd of 150 prisoners who witnessed Davenport's Bishop Ralph L. Hayes confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on 39 inmates.

The attendance at the service was one of the largest in years. About 75 received Holy Communion.

The majority of those in the confirmation class were converts who had been instructed and baptized by Father Bernard E. Brugman, prison chaplain.

Zurich, Switzerland — (RNS) — Roman Catholics in Zurich, long a stronghold of Swiss Protestantism, now number 41,636, or 23.5 per cent of the total population, according to latest statistics published here.

The increase was attributed to the large number of non-Swiss, notably Italians, who have come to work here in recent years.

Protestants were reported to make up 62.1 per cent of the population, Old Catholics, 0.8 per cent, and Jews, 1.4 per cent. Those belonging to other faiths or professing no religion accounted for the balance of 2.2 per cent.

Swiss Cistercians Open U.S. Convent

Frauenthal, Switzerland — (NC) Six Cistercian nuns from the Frauenthal convent in the Canton of Zug will leave their community to establish a new convent in Wisconsin.

The six were chosen from among the 134 who volunteered to leave Switzerland for the United States. The Wisconsin convent, to be located at Baraboo, about 30 miles north of Madison, will be known as New Frauenthal.

Frauenthal is one of the oldest convents in Switzerland, having been established in 1231. Cistercian nuns dedicate their lives to prayer and meditation. They earn part of their subsistence by making liturgical vestments.
