

## 'Don Camillo' Play Listed, Radio, TV Shows Scheduled

Winooski Park, Vt. — (NC) — Dominican Father Gilbert F. Hartke, whose show business career dates back to his boyhood when he was one of the "End Kids," flew here from Washington to cast "The Little World of Don Camillo." The play, written by the father, was the final attraction from August 13 to 17 of Players, Inc., at St. Michael's Playhouse on the campus of St. Michael's College here.

PLAYERS, INC., is the alumni group of the speech and drama department of the Catholic University of America. Father Hartke is director of the university department.

The Dominican will return later to put the finishing touches on his play dealing with the running series of battles between the priest, Don Camillo, and the communist mayor of a little Italian village.

Father Hartke wrote the play from the best seller book by Giovanni Guareschi. It will be the final attraction from August 13 to 17 of Players, Inc., at St. Michael's Playhouse on the campus of St. Michael's College here.

## No Vacation At Pope's Summer Palace

High up in the Albano Hills some 15 miles from Rome lies the little town of Castel Gandolfo.

Its streets and houses are typical of any small Italian town, but there is a difference. Castel Gandolfo is the site of the Papal summer residence.

Each year, as the summer heat of Rome becomes oppressive, Pope Pius XII leaves the confines of the stately, walled City of the Vatican and goes to his retreat in the hills, where the cool breezes enable him to better bear the burdens of a 20-hour day.

**THE POPE'S** annual transfer to Castel Gandolfo is not a vacation, but merely a respite from the excessive heat of the Roman summer. While at the summer palace, the Pontiff maintains a rigid working schedule and continues to hold audiences.

Despite recent ill health, Pope Pius has not reduced the amount of work he does in governing a church of 400,000,000 souls.

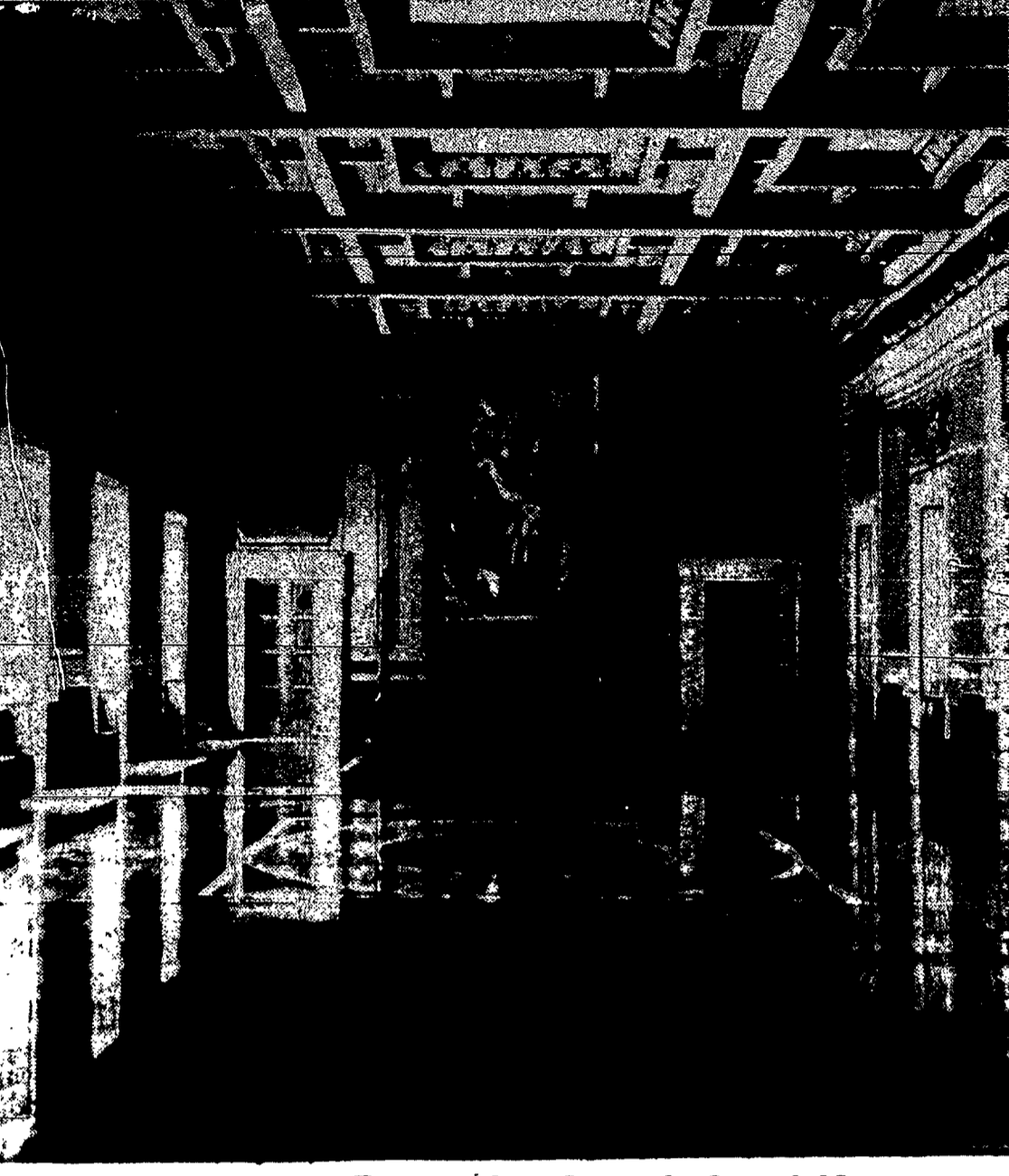
The famous papal summer palace, which overlooks Lake Albano, has been a Vatican possession since early in the 17th century, when it was purchased from the Savelli family, who sold the property to meet pressing debts.

Even before the Lateran Treaty of 1929, it enjoyed, along with the Vatican, the right of extraterritoriality, making it free from government inspection or visitation without papal authority.

CASTEL GANDOLFO had no particular function in the life and history of the Popes until Pope Urban VIII (1623-44) decided to make it a summer residence. The first Pontiff actually to seek rest and recuperation there was Alexander VII (1655-67). Since then, the palace has undergone various architectural additions. These were finally finished in 1936, during the pontificate of Pope Pius XI.

Castel Gandolfo was used by the Popes until 1869, when the occupation of Rome by Italian troops ushered in a period of "protest" which caused it to be unused for about 60 years. The recent epoch of the castle dates from the Lateran Pact of 1929.

The Holy Father's apartment at Castel Gandolfo is on the second floor. The floor above is reserved for the astronomers of the Vatican Observatory.

Large groups of pilgrims seeking audience with Pope Pius XII during his stay at Castel Gandolfo are customarily received in this beautiful, vaulted room. Although audiences are rarely curtailed at the papal summer residence, the Pontiff continues to see special groups.

The GRANDUEUR of the rooms and gardens is incidental as far as Pope Pius XII is concerned. For he is known to be a man of simple tastes and lives a life of rigid austerity.

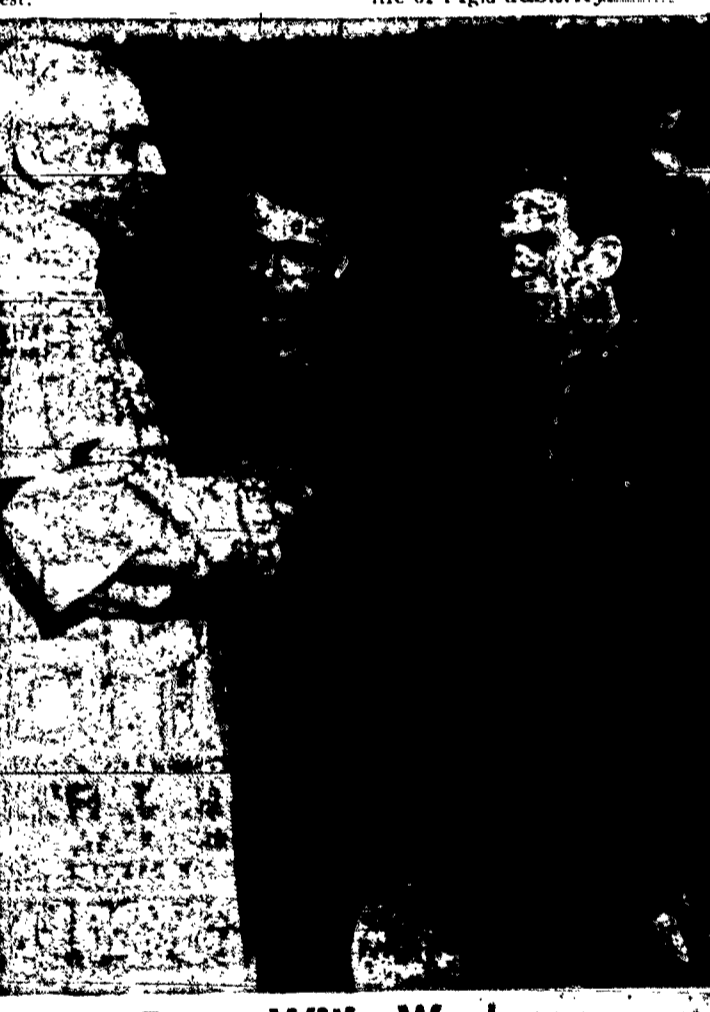
