

Shrine Pilgrimage
Draws Over 1,000
Isle La Motte, Vt.—(NC)—More than 1,000 persons from at least eight states and Quebec Province, attended the annual pilgrimage here at St. Anne's Shrine.

Bishop Robert F. Joyce of Burlington offered a Pontifical Mass at the shrine and gave Communion to many persons. The Bishop dedicated St. Anne's Church in Milton, where several hundred Vermonters continued on the 81st year of the diocesan pilgrimage.

The first official diocesan pilgrimage was held at St. Anne's in Milton, preceding the one at Isle La Motte by 23 years.

The first Catholic Mass in Vermont was offered on the site of the Isle La Motte shrine on July 26, 1666, according to a marker located opposite the chapel entrance.

The Scapular Medal

THOSE CAREFUL to adhere to the wording of decrees should note that although all the indulgences of all the Scapulars (18 in number) are attached to this medal, the distinguishing reward of assured salvation, attached to the Brown Scapular (and making this devotion of Our Lady of Mount Carmel primary among devotions to Mary), is not mentioned in the papal decree on the medal.

The Rev. A. J. Vermeersch, S.J., interpreting the institution of the medal (which was primarily granted for natives in the tropics, who could not fittingly wear the cloth Scapular), said, "I would prefer that, in order to honor the principal Scapular, which is that of Carmel, the Brown Scapular be worn in the accustomed form and the medal only as a substitute for the other Scapulars, in order that one may not have to wear too many."

POPE PIUS X himself, who made the Scapular medal decree, in an audience with the Venerable Joseph Recorder said, "I did not intend that the Scapular medal should supplant the Brown Scapular in Europe and America. I wear the cloth, His Holiness added, "let us never take it off!"

The reasons advanced by individual Catholics against wearing the Scapular seem to me to be rooted in a distaste for the inconvenience of the cloth rather than in any logical reason. For those who have an allergy for wool it is possible now to get Scapulars with nylon, tarnish proof metal, or sterling silver chains, and the Scapular itself may be coated with or inclosed in various clear plastics.

The Scapular medal may represent, besides the Brown Scapular, all the other scapulars. This medal should carry a cast of Our Divine Lord showing the Sacred Heart on the obverse, and of Our Lady, under any of her titles, on the reverse. It must be worn on one's person, either around the neck or in any other suitable way.

Designer Urges U.S. Women To Wear Spanish Mantillas
Washington—(NC)—American Catholic women who forget to bring a head covering to church may well find the solution to their problem in the Spanish mantilla.

The usefulness and attractiveness of the traditional Spanish headpiece are described by Miss Anne Fogarty, noted fashion authority, in an article appearing in the September issue of the Catholic Digest.

Miss Fogarty says she "discovered" the value of the mantilla two years ago in a little town in southern Spain. She was about to enter a small church when she realized her head and shoulders were bare. As she turned away, an old woman who had observed her predicament offered Miss Fogarty a mantilla.

While traveling through Spain, Portugal and Italy, Miss Fogarty says she saw "the mantilla worn with pride on the streets, in churches, and even at formal social functions."

She explains that the mantilla is particularly useful because "it can assume many 'looks.' As a simple square carried in the pocket by women who do not care to be bothered with a hat, it is always ready at hand for morning Mass or a quick afternoon visit to the Blessed Sacrament." She notes "there is now a tiny mantilla that is made especially to be tucked between the pages of a missal."
