### Mt. Saviour's First Candidate Is Ordained

Mount Saviour Monastery's first candidate for the priesthood was ordained Sunday August 4, in the Abbey of St. Benedict-du-Lac, Prov. of Quebec, Canada.

Father Augustine McGowan, O.S.B., son of Mrs. William McGowan of Cheshire, Conn., and the late Mr. McGowan, received the priesthood from the Archbishop Georges Cabana, of Sherbrooke.

FATHER AUGUSTINE entered the Elmira monastery July 5, 1952. He made his novitiate at the Canadian abbey and took his first vows at Mount Saviour in March, 1954. He was sent to the International Benedictine College of St. Anselmo, Rome, where he continued his theological studies. There he made his final vows on March 25, 1957.

He was ordained subdeacon and deacon at Subiaco, Italy, where St. Benedict, author of the Rule followed by the monks, established himself at the end of the 5th Century.

Before entering Mount Saviour, Father Augustine was graduated from Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C., and received his M.A. degree in Philosophy from Notre Dame University. He served in the U.S. Army from 1944-46.

On August 15, feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, he will celebrate his first High Mass at Mount Saviour at 9 a.m. Friends of the monastery are invited.
