Catholic Groups Share In Bequests of 3 Wills

Four Catholic groups and the Rochester Community Chest share in the will of **Augustine J. Cunningham** admitted to probate in Surrogate's Court, August 6. The five groups get bequests totaling \$50,000. **Mr. Cunningham**, 79 of 1000 East Ave., prominent industrialist and active Catholic layman died July 31, 1957. He was president of **Jarvis Cunningham and Son Co. Inc.**

Bequests included in the will are \$10,000 each to St. Ann's Home for the Aged, St. Mary's Hospital, Corpus Christi Church, Rochester Community Chest and the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. The legacy to the last named is for Masses. The Community Chest bequest is in trust, the income to be used for the benefit of Chest agencies.

Mr. Cunningham also directed that a sum be placed in trust with Security Trust Co. sufficient to yield income of at least \$200 a year to be paid to Corpus Christi Church to assure Masses for **Mr. Cunningham's** mother, the late **Mrs. Ellen N. Cunningham**, and for altar candles in the church. Security Trust Co. is executor of the will. **Alfred W. Dunbar** of Nixon, Hargrave, Devans and Day appeared as attorney.

The will of the late **Oscar A. Wanzenaker**, 29 Welder St. specified that four Catholic groups share in the residue of the estate. **Mr. Wanzenaker**, a retired machine tool worker, who died at 67 on June 9, 1957, left an estate of at least \$200,000 according to his attorney and executor, **Benedict L. Miller**.

After specific bequests of \$2,800, the will said the residue should be divided among St. Boniface Church, Rochester; School of the Holy Childhood, St. Bernard Seminary and St. Ann's Home for the Aged.

Three Catholic groups will share in the estate of **Mrs. Emma F. Ameel**, 88, of 440 Lake View Park who died Feb. 14, 1957 according to her will probated in Surrogate Court, last week. Of her estimated \$8,100 estate.
