**ANGANI WOMEN**  
**Pre-School Education**  
By Mary Lennon Snyder  
WHENEVER PARENTS question what to do to prepare the child for kindergarten or first grade, I generally refer them to our Family Circle by Sister Jean Patrice because her conclusions and advice are based on years of work with children in the early years of school.  
Sister Jean Patrice, while not arguing against nursery schools, feels, as we all do that there is no substitute for a mother in the formative pre-school years. She points out "The back yard may be small and his play equipment may be meager, but if Johnny can look up from his sandpile and see his mother through the kitchen window, and if Mary knows that her first cry of pain or fright will bring her mother rushing to the rescue, then Johnny and Mary have something that the best-equipped, best staffed nursery school in the world cannot supply, and it should not be taken away from them."  
"UNFORTUNATELY there are many conscientious parents who have the idea that nursery school is essential to prepare their child for kindergarten or first grade. It is not. Neither is it necessary to teach four-year old Mary and Johnny to print their names in large sprawling capital letters.  
"That sort of preparation is not appreciated by any teacher for the simple reason that it means the teacher has to un-teach one skill before she can teach another. Today, children are taught (in school) to print their name in script, not in capitals.  
"So when teacher says to Johnny, "This is your name," Johnny may be politely stubborn as he insists: "It is not. This is my name. My mother said so." It does not augur for an auspicious beginning in first grade. When adult authorities conflict, the child in the middle is always the loser.  
"THE SAME MAY be said for teaching a child to rattle off his ABC's or to count to one hundred or to acquire some other bit of unrelated learning. Strange as it may seem, children today learn to read before they learn the alphabet. Times certainly have changed, haven't they?  
"Does this mean that you should send your Johnny or your Mary into the school world without any preparation of any kind whatever? No, it does not mean anything of the kind. There is a type of preparation for school which is within the reach of every parent and the importance of which cannot be too emphatically stressed.  
"That is to provide Johnny and Mary with a background of experience which will not merely enrich their knowledge of the world about them and widen their horizons, but will further enable them to perceive reality in their own surroundings. We will foster habits and form judgments for themselves. If you do that for your children, you will have done them a service which can never be duplicated by all the

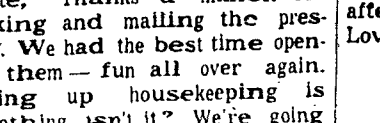
