The couple is residing at 309 East Hoover Avenue in Killeen, Texas.

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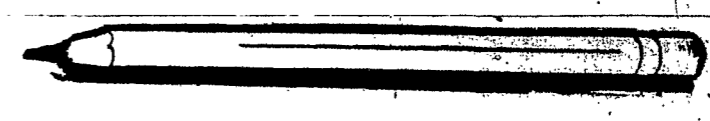
