Panama Nuncio Named Canada Bp. Valdez City (RNS)—Archbishop Paul Bernier, Papal Nuncio to Panama, has been named Bishop of Gaspe, Canada, by Pope Pius XII. He succeeds Bishop Albin Leblanc who was killed in an automobile accident last May. The new bishop will retain the personal title of Archbishop conferred upon him when he was named to the Panama post in 1952. He was born in Quebec in 1906 and was ordained in 1928.
