

Geneva Blue Army Meets, Fatima Statue Visits Homes

Geneva — First fall meeting of the Blue Army of Our Lady of Fatima, which was formed in St. Francis de Sales Parish last year was held Sunday in the school hall.

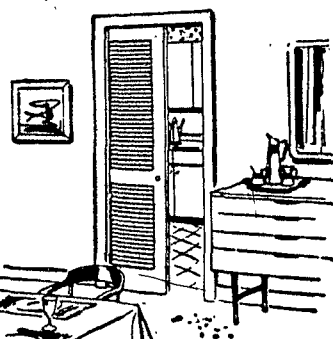
Sliding Door Saves Space

Space savers are important in today's smaller, more compact homes. A useful trick of this kind is a sliding-louver door between kitchen and dining room, as shown in the drawing.

By gliding smoothly out of the way, this door of ponderosa pine doesn't take up space swinging out into the room as do conventional doors. With the door closed, the louvers let air circulate, keeping the kitchen from becoming hot and stuffy.

The door can be painted or stained on each side to match colors or wood tones used in both rooms. Louver doors of ponderosa pine can be obtained from building materials dealers in many stock sizes and styles, ready to be installed.

The sliding louver door idea also is a good one for other



rooms in the house, especially closets. The louvers permit circulation of air in closets, preventing mustiness. Installed between rooms, the louver doors make heating and air-conditioning systems more efficient.

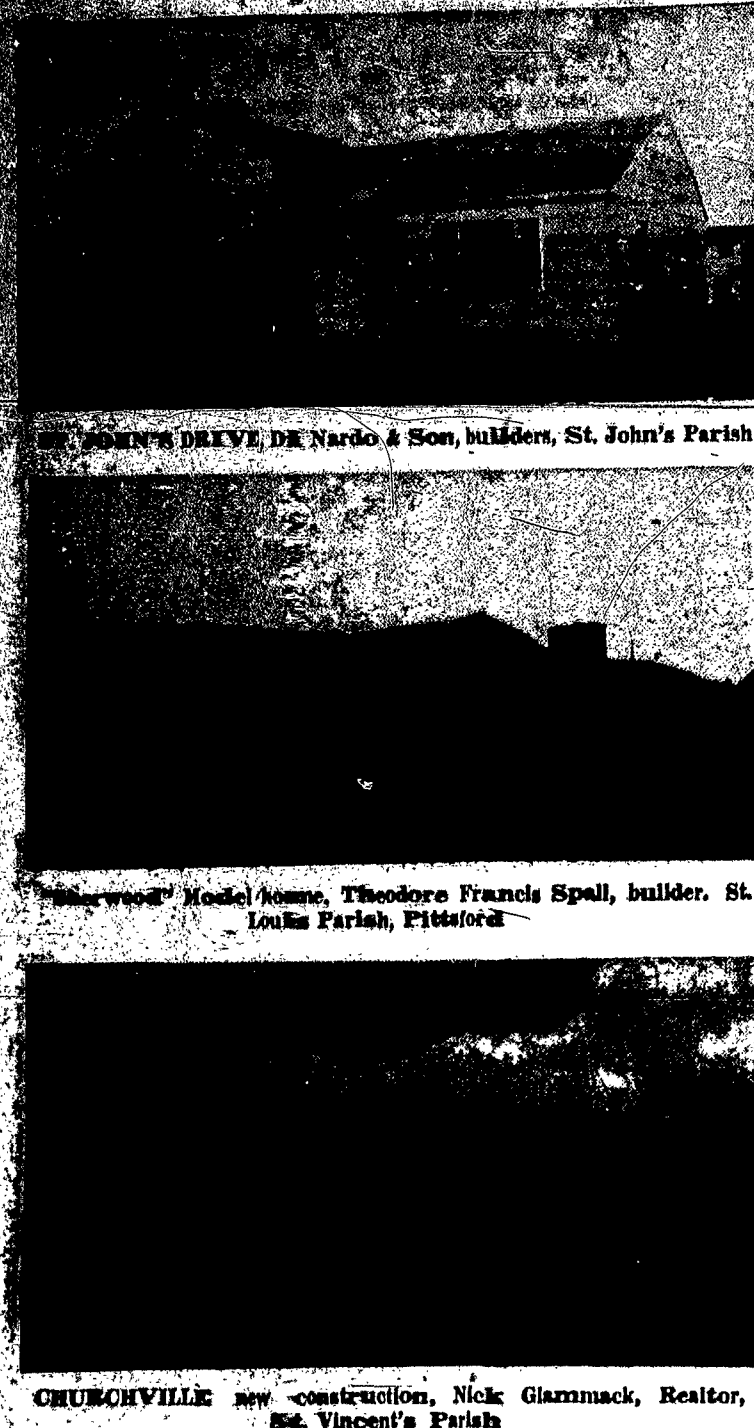
