# St. Charles Men Enroll In Church Campaign

Final days of activity in a drive to raise \$100,000 for church building in Elmira Heights began with the presentation of the architect's sketch of the proposed building. The Rev. Joseph G. ## Ukrainian Church Pastor To Mark Golden Jubilee

Very Rev. Waldimir B. Dowhovich, pastor of St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church, Elmira Heights will be honored on Sunday evening, Oct. 6 with a banquet at Mark Twain Hotel to mark the 50th anniversary of his Ordination to the Holy Priesthood.

The Rev. Waldimir Maselko, assistant pastor, is honorary chairman and the general chairman is Francis Kosulich. Members of the Holy Name Society, St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church, Elmira Heights will be honored on Sunday evening, Oct. 6 with a banquet at Mark Twain Hotel to mark the 50th anniversary of his Ordination to the Holy Priesthood.

Two years after his ordination, Father Dowhovich was called to the United States by the late Bishop Stephen Soter Ortynski, first Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Diocese of the U.S.

His first assignment was in Cleveland where he was without a church or congregation. Working in his untiring fashion, he assembled a congregation and built a church on Cleveland's westside. Other assignments included Pittsburgh and Allentown in Pennsylvania and at Detroit, Mich.

SINCE COMING to Elmira Heights the Jubilarian has made remarkable progress in furthering the work of the parish. He organized The Sacred Heart Society, the Sodality of the Blessed Virgin and was the prime mover in establishing the Fashion-Macekur Ukrainian Catholic Post 1178 of the Catholic War Veterans.

Ground was broken for a new church edifice to accommodate the vastly increased congregation and it is expected that the dedication will take place some time around Easter of 1958.

Rev. Nicholas P. Wolensky of Rochester will act as toastmaster. Other guests will include priests from the Elmira area, Ukrainian Catholic Priests from Auburn, Binghamton, Syracuse and area civic officials.

FATHER DOWHOVICH was born Dec. 9, 1884 in Soroky, five miles from Lviv, Capital City of Galicia, Western Ukraine. He attended gymnasium (high school) in Zolochiv and after graduating entered the Theological Seminary in Lviv.

Completing his studies, he was ordained to the Ukrainian Catholic Priesthood by the late Metropolitan Julia Bleier will preside.
