500 See Bishop Casey Dedicate New Lourdes School, Elmira

Solemn dedication ceremonies were conducted Saturday by His Excellency, the Bishop of Elmira, at the new Lourdes School, Elmira. Over 500 parishioners, including 250 Sisters from throughout the diocese, were in attendance.

CEREMONIES were held in the church where the Bishop spoke of the importance of Catholic education. He said the new school is a step in the right direction in the city of Elmira.

Following the ceremonies, an open house was held during which the public inspected the school and met the Sisters of Mercy who teach at the school. The Ladies Rosary-Altar Society served a buffet luncheon to the nuns.

The new school, which was opened for the first time this fall, is located at Demarest Pkwy. and W. First St. in West Elmira. Construction of the school began in 1956 and the cornerstone was laid last October. It has eight classrooms, a kindergarten and other modern facilities. It is one story of stone construction.

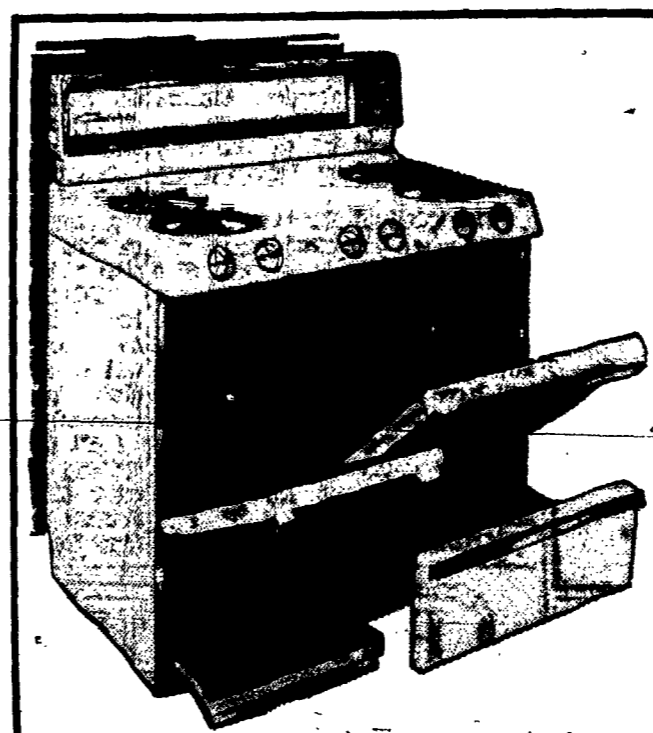
