

School Board Seeks Bus Ban Reversal

Toms River — (RNS) — The Central Regional High School Board of Education voted here today to appeal to the Appellate Division of the New Jersey Superior Court against a ruling that its buses may not carry parochial school children from kindergarten through the sixth grade.

In September, the State Board of Education upheld an opinion by State Commissioner of Education Frederick M. R. Berger. He ruled that since the regional school board was established for a junior-senior high school, it could not provide bus transportation for children of the primary and intermediate grades of parochial schools.

The State Commissioner said pupils from the seventh and eighth grades could be transported on the buses from kindergarten through the sixth grade without charge.

Prelate Asks Fund Aid For Retarded Children

Lynn, Mass. — (RNS) — Archbishop Richard J. Cushing of Boston urged here that federal, state and municipal governments provide funds to build schools for retarded children and facilities to train personnel in caring for them.

DECLARING that the problem of educating retarded children is one that "cries to heaven for universal sympathy," the archbishop said a "good test of civilization is the care it takes of the most helpless."

He addressed the North Shore Association for Retarded Children.

"I see no reason why any man or woman who aspires to the legislature should not be questioned about his interest in these children," Archbishop Cushing said.
