Niagara University, N. Y.—Niagara University has been given a grant of \$2,000 by the Esso Education Foundation, according to an announcement by the Very Rev. Vincent T. Swords, C.M., university president.

Father Swords said that the Foundation offered the grant without restrictions, except that the Esso funds help meet expenses directly associated with undergraduate education.

Eugene Holman, chairman of the foundation, explained that the purpose of the grant is to aid the nation's colleges and universities financially so that they may continue to meet the ever higher intellectual standards of modern society.
