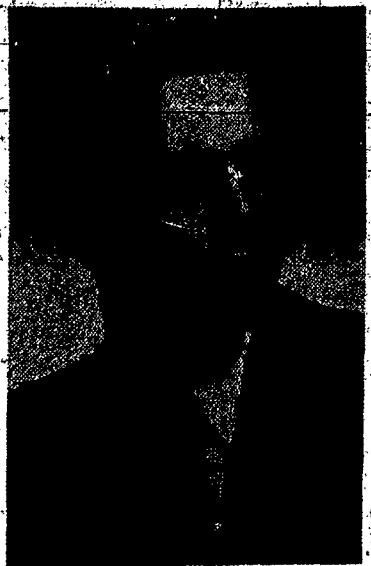
He spoke on "World Peace and the part the United States plays in its attainment."
