**Supreme Court Reverses Ban On French Movie**

Washington — (NC) — The Supreme Court has struck down a Chicago ban against showing the French-made film, "Game of Love."

In its brief "per curiam" order, the nation's highest court simply cited the case of *Alberts versus California* which it decided last term. There were no arguments before the court.

"GAME OF LOVE" was banned from Chicago movie houses by the Police Censor Board there on the basis that the film was "immoral and obscene." The board is charged with reviewing films.

Denial of a permit for exhibition was upheld in both the Federal District Court and the seventh U.S. Circuit of Appeals in Chicago. It was the decision of the latter court that the Supreme Court unanimously reversed.

"Game of Love," distributed by Times Film Corporation, has been rated "C," or condemned, by the National Legion of Decency.

In the *Alberts* case, the court said standards for judging obscenity must also safeguard freedom of speech for material not treating sex by prurient interest.

THE OPINION given by the Chicago Circuit Court about the film, developed in an atmosphere of sensuality, dwell without relief upon suggestiveness in costuming, dialogue and situations. In the field of motion picture entertainment the extent and intensity of the objectionability of this picture constitute an open violation of Christian and traditional morality."

**'Rome Eternal' A TV First To Show Pope, Vatican**

New York — The exciting, yet reverent, life of Rome and Vatican City, past and present will be presented for the first time on television in "Rome Eternal," a four-part film series on the NBC-TV network.

Jan. 5, 12, 19 and 26. One of the first major productions of the 1958 TV season, it will be seen on The Catholic Hour.

The telecast will be seen in the Rochester area over WROC-TV, Channel 5 from 1:50 to 3 p.m. on the above dates.

Through "Rome Eternal," the American TV audience will view the first motion pictures of St. Peter's tomb, deep under St. Peter's Basilica; Pope Pius XII in audience at St. Peter's and at his summer residence; the genius of Michelangelo; the great art treasures of Rome and the Vatican; the ingenious structures of classical Rome; and the life and activities of modern Rome and Vatican City.

"ROME ETHERNAL," co-produced by NBC and the National Council of Catholic Men, was more than a year in the planning. It is the largest single project undertaken by The Catholic Hour in its six years on television.

Pulitzer-Prize-winning author Paul Hogan wrote the narrative, and original music was composed for the film by Jacques Belasco.

The first of the four half-hour films, "The City of Peter," will be shown Jan. 5. It will reconstruct the life of rich, pagan imperial Rome; then trace the transition from paganism to Christianity.

"THE CITY OF FAITH," Jan. 12, will show the liberation of the Church and the influence of Roman art and architecture on Western civilization.

"Renaissance Rome," Jan. 19, will depict the spirit that inspired Michelangelo and his contemporaries. The beauty of the Christian Renaissance will be shown in the great art treasures of Vatican Palace, in the rooms of the Vatican, in the tradition of the Swiss Guard, in Roman buildings, courts, and sculpture.

"Our Moment in Time," Jan. 26, will present modern Rome and the activities of the Vatican and Pope Pius XII. Among the featured scenes will be the interior and exterior beauty of St. Peter's, the streets, buildings, shops, and gardens of Vatican City, the people and their way of life, and the person of the Holy Father.
