### German Reds Attack Religion Classes

Berlin—(RNS)—East German Communists have broadened their anti-religious campaign to include attacks on after-school religious instruction classes conducted by the Protestant and Roman Catholic Churches.

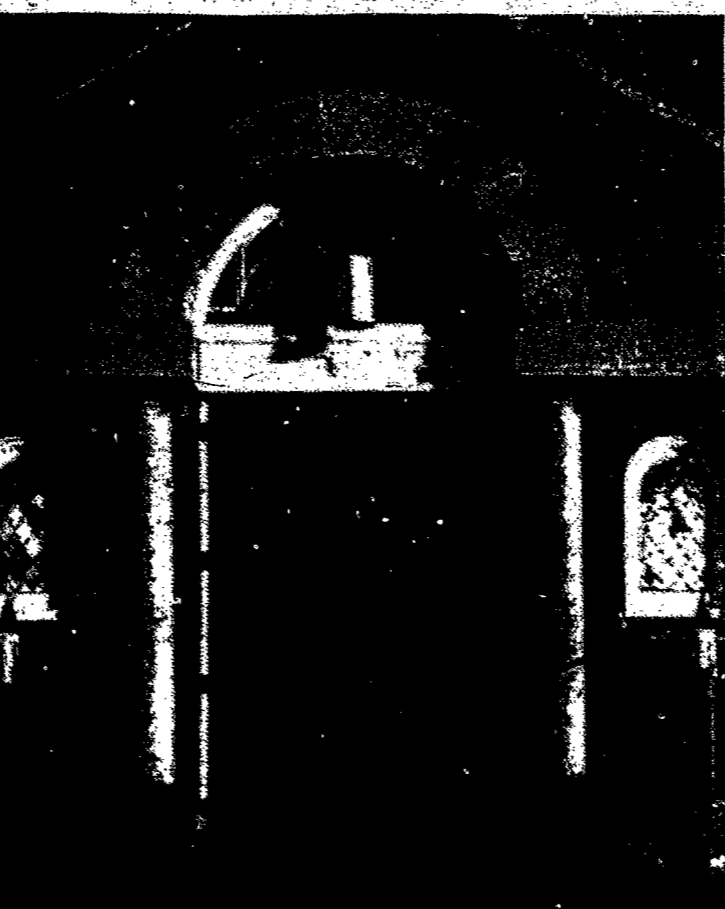
Local Communist publications and officials made statements denouncing the Churches for "increased attempts to infect the children with this poison."

The Red organs accused catechists of forcing children at the end of the regular school day to attend religion classes.


The arrested priests are Father Ludewig, pastor in nearby Wiedelah, and his visitor, Jesuit Father Alfonso Gesinger from Brazil.

### Ethiopia Names First Minister To Vatican

Addis Ababa, Ethiopia—(RNS)—Major Mesfin Bagashet has been named Ethiopia's first minister to the Vatican. He formerly was Ethiopian Charge d'Affaires in Mexico.

## Public Colleges Enroll 58 Percent

Washington—(NC)—The U.S. Office of Education stands here that 58 per cent of last fall's college population of 3,068,000 are enrolled in publicly controlled institutions, as against 57.1 per cent in the fall of 1956.

Public institutions reported a 5.9 per cent gain in the number of students over the fall of 1956, while privately controlled institutions listed 1.8 per cent more than last year, the office said.

Its figures are published in the January, 1958, issue of the publication, Higher Education, a no-breakdown by religious denomination is made in statistics on private colleges in the survey, which was made by the section of the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

The college and university population for the fall of 1956 was put at 2,947,000 and the total for 1957 amounted to a 4.1 per cent increase, said the office.

It added that the present enrollment would rise to an estimated all-time high of 3,460,000 after the opening of the second semester in the nation's institutions of higher learning.

"It is hoped," President Nolan said, "that this event will promote the wishes of Bishop Kearney that the entire family receive the Blessed Sacrament together and that mother be spared her usual task of preparing breakfast."

Basil Oleksyn is breakfast chairman and James Philippone, co-chairman. They will be assisted by a large group of Holy Name men who will prepare the food. Serving, this year, will be by 75 girls scouts from the three troops of St. Charles.

Reservations may be made after all Masses on Sunday, Jan. 5.

Your Excellency:  
I got the idea to make a great sacrifice by sending my eighty bucks to the Holy Father for his missions. These \$80 were my savings for buying my used car. Well, after a great struggle I decided on sending the money to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. The only reason why I decided to do that was because I once heard that if you give with love until it hurts that is a sacrifice. I also figure that a missionary.

By the way, Excellency, I am a Catholic teenager. I thought you'd like to know that.

Let those who sometimes despair of teenagers rejoice to see what is good in the hearts of the young!

THIS TEENAGER REVEALS an unusual insight into the missionary life of the Church. He saw that the only way to aid all missionaries equally was to place his offering in the hands of the Holy Father. He was wise enough also to know that the way to do this was to give it to the Holy Father's own Society for the Propagation of the Faith, for every cent received there may be distributed only by the Vicar of Christ.
