And the lost glasses! The poor Saint is beleaguered keeping track of eyeglasses for the Head of the House, Ginny and myself.

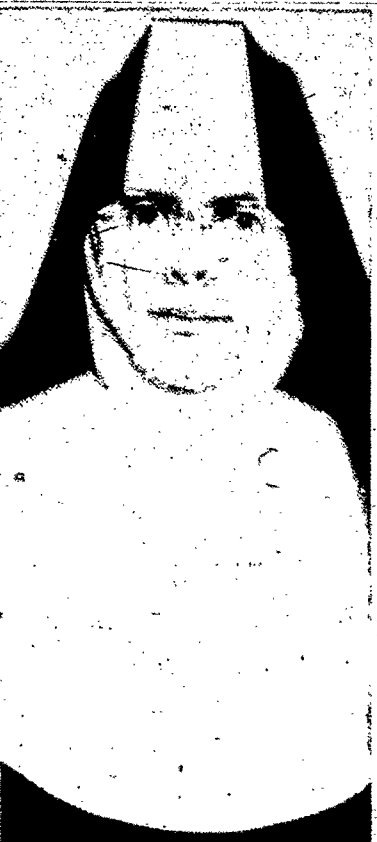

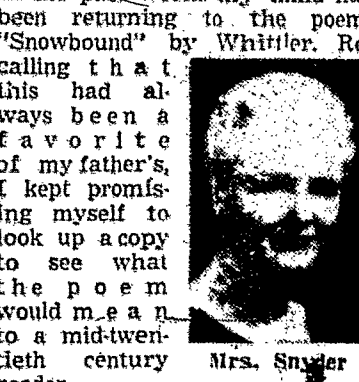
