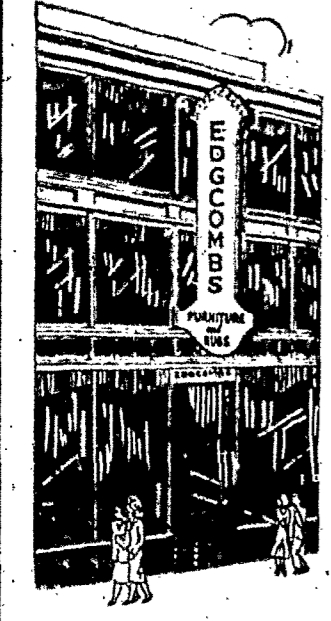
Father Nolan said the Capping ceremony is the first step towards the completing of a noble vocation. External ceremony indicates internal dedication to nursing ideals.
