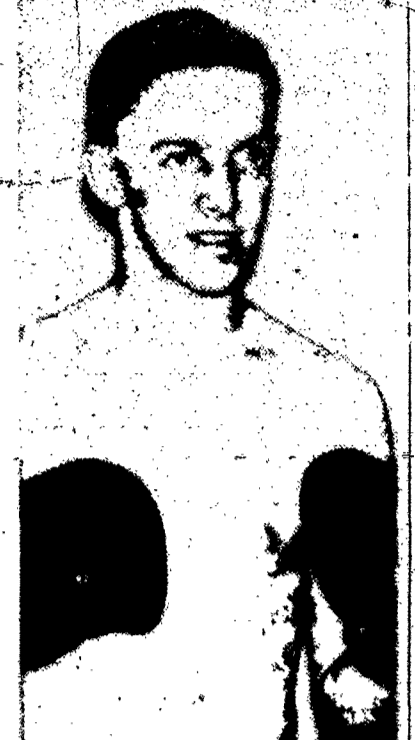


Former Aquinas Champ Seeks Second Title
