A HUNDRED YEARS FROM NOW men will see that Communism played into the Hands of God. As Joseph said to his breihren who sold him into slavery: "You intended it for evil, but God intended it for good." Already we can see that the blood of martyrs through Communism has become the seed of Christians in Korea.

ONE PRIEST ALONE has 450 converts under instruction. Other priests have convert classes in from ten to twenty-six villages, traveling from one to the other on blcycle.
